Freedom fighters yesterday demanded of the government to ensure all state facilities declaring them as 'National Pride Force.'

They urged the government not to pay any allowances to freedom fighters through the social welfare ministry which is headed by a Razakar, the local collaborator of Pakistani occupation forces.

The freedom fighters made the demands at a meeting of the preparatory committee of their National Convention in the city. An 11-point charter of demand was placed in the meeting.

The freedom fighters demanded expulsion of all anti-liberation people from the cabinet immediately. They also called for preparing a list of the freedom fighters in an impartial manner

"The freedom fighters fought the liberation war with a dream to establish a non-communal Bangladesh, but we have failed to materialise their dream," said Abul Barkat, general secretary of Bangladesh Economic Association.

The anti-liberation forces are alarmingly increasing their hold in the country, he said, adding, "The total profit of the Jamaat-e-Islamibacked different organisations now stands at Tk 1206 crore a year, and it is possible to recruit 10 lakh full timers if they just use 10 percent of this total profit.


