


- 1. This request for expressions of interest follows the General Procurement Notice (GPN) for the Social Investment Program Project (SIPP) that appeared in the Development Business issue no 588 of August 16, 2002
- 2. The People's Republic of Bangladesh has received a credit from the International Development Association (IDA) towards the cost of the SIPP and intends to apply part of the proceeds of this credit towards eligible payments under the contract for implementing the Social Assistance Program (SAP) of the project by Organizations referred as Participating Organization (PO) in this project
- 3. The project is under implementation in two districts in Bangladesh Gaibandha and Jamalpur. In each district, approximately 700 villages will be covered over a four year period. The SAP will be implemented in the similar number of villages and will be targeted at the poorest and vulnerable people. Four PO is already operating the activities in 500 villages in two districts under phase one and two. The expected duration of the service under phase three would be two years covering approximately 225 villages in each district subject to satisfactory performance, which would be reviewed bi-annually. To provide results-oriented incentives, performance based contracts will be used.
- 4. The scope of work of PO would include: (a) social mobilization, group formation; human development and leadership training; (b) creating awareness through advocacy programs about immunization, women's health, nutrition, clean water and sanitation, education, rights (understanding of laws relating to family, violence against women, child labor, rights of the children, local mediation (Shalish), alternative dispute resolution in natural and common property resources governance issues); (c) occupational skills training; (d) legal aid services; and (e) social assistance for tribal population.
- 5. Social Development Foundation (SDF) now invites eligible organizations to indicate their interest in providing these services. Interested Organizations must provide information indicating that they are qualified to perform these services (annual reports, external evaluation reports, description of similar assignments, experience in similar conditions knowledge of local issues and community needs, availability of appropriate skills in participatory planning). This includes.
