

G-21 urges US, EU to abolish export subsidies in 5 years

Uruguay joins bloc as 21st member

The Group of 21 developing countries yesterday asked the United States and European countries to eliminate their export subsidies in five years and reduce domestic support to agriculture.

A declaration issued at the end of the two-day G-21 (Uruguay is the 21st country which joined G-20 in Delhi meeting on Friday) ministerial meeting here said the developing countries demand that the developed nations substantially cut trade-distorting domestic support and phase out export subsidies in agriculture "within five years, with front-loading commitments".

Addressing a joint press conference with trade ministers of the G-21 member countries, Indian Commerce Minister Kamal Nath said elimination of export subsidies was of critical importance as it created artificiality in prices denying market access to developing countries. "This trade-distorting subsidy must be eliminated first", he added.

Speaking on behalf of the Group, he said rules must be "equitable, fair and just" to all countries in view of special circumstances of

their development levels.

The five-page declaration, issued in the run-up to the Hong Kong ministerial meeting of World Trade Organization (WTO) in December this year, said "We can't have one country or small group of countries dictating the rules to all members" and cautioned against attempts by developed countries to divide developing nations through their further categorization.

Yesterday's declaration came despite reservations of certain Latin American countries and assumed significance with the presence of representatives of influential developing countries like China, Brazil, South Africa, Argentina, Indonesia, Thailand and Mexico.

Brazilian Foreign Minister and Group coordinator Celso Amorim said "There may be points of differences on nuances but G-21 is solid like a rock and represents unity in diversity."

The five-year term set by the G-21 is far ahead of the 2012 deadline European Union has set for its member countries to reduce farm subsidies to a minimum. The US is yet to agree to any timeframe but

says it will reciprocate if developing countries cut their tariffs and liberalise their markets.

The declaration also sought to put pressure on the US and EU to make tariffs on both farm and non-farm goods based on value rather than units as well as their ingredients.

Nath, in his opening address on Friday, had termed agriculture the core issue in the Doha Work Programme for developing countries and sought an end to billions of dollars of trade subsidies imposed by developed countries to their farmers.

The decision to demand elimination of export subsidies by developed countries within five years is likely to put developing countries on a collision course with the US and EU.

According to Nath, the rich countries pay subsidies worth one billion dollars every day and these trade-distorting concessions need to be ended soon.

The Delhi meeting of G-21 was attended by representatives from countries including Pakistan, Cuba, Chile, Venezuela, Egypt, Bolivia, Paraguay, Guyana, Nigeria, Zambia and Guatemala.

Ex-WorldCom directors agree to pay millions in settlement

Eleven former WorldCom directors have agreed to pay 20 million dollars (15 million euros) out of their own pockets to settle a civil lawsuit filed on behalf of investors against the failed telecom giant, The New York Times said Saturday.

Under the terms of the deal, insurance companies that provided WorldCom directors and officers liability coverage will pay 35 million dollars, the Times said.

Earlier this week former WorldCom chief executive Bernard Ebbers was found guilty of being the mastermind of the 11-billion-dollar (8.25-billion-euro) fraud that forced the telecom giant into bankruptcy last year, renamed MCI Inc.

The directors' settlement is seen as "a rare case of investors holding directors accountable for problems occurring on their watch," the Times said.

Wal-Mart settles labour suit for \$11m

Wal-Mart Stores Inc on Friday said it would pay a record \$11 million to settle a civil probe by U.S. authorities into allegations it knowingly hired floor-cleaning contractors who employed illegal aliens.

The world's largest retailer said the government will not pursue any criminal charges against Wal-Mart or any of its employees.

The deal resolves a more than four-year-long Department of Justice investigation into the employment practices of the company's former floor-cleaning contractors.

"This case breaks new ground... because this a record dollar amount for a civil immigration settlement" and because Wal-Mart has to set up an internal compliance program, said Michael Garcia, a Department of Homeland Security official.

Top donors Japan, US to coordinate foreign aid

Japan and the United States, the world's two largest donors in dollar terms, pledged Saturday to coordinate their foreign aid to help focus the impact of assistance to the developing world.

US Secretary of State Condoleezza Rice unveiled the idea, which she terms the "Strategic Development Alliance," on her first visit to Japan since becoming the top US diplomat, although the practicalities are still to be worked out.

"Today I propose a strategic development alliance for our two countries to sit down and regularly, systematically focus our efforts to advance these common objectives in countries where we are already working side by side," Rice said.

"Our alliance is not just about

security and stability. It is an alliance of compassion," she said in a speech at Sophia University in Tokyo.

She said the world's two largest economies together provided about 40 percent of the governmental assistance given to developing countries.

"We support human development founded on economic opportunity and in partnership with governments willing to accept their share of responsibility," she said.

She stressed the alliance was not meant to be exclusive.

"We should also welcome the participation of others who can usefully contribute to this work," she said.

Japanese Foreign Minister Nobutaka Machimura offered his backing to coordinating aid.

"Japan agrees with it wholeheartedly," Machimura said.
