The gang riding on motorbikes intercepted the autorickshaw near the Sylhet centre of Radio Bangladesh. They asked Matin to hand over the bag, but when he refused, they stabbed him and sped away with the bag. At about 4:00pm, Kotwali police found the metal detectors lying abandoned in nearby Sagardighirpar area. They also arrested JCD cadres Abdus Sabur and Anwar.
