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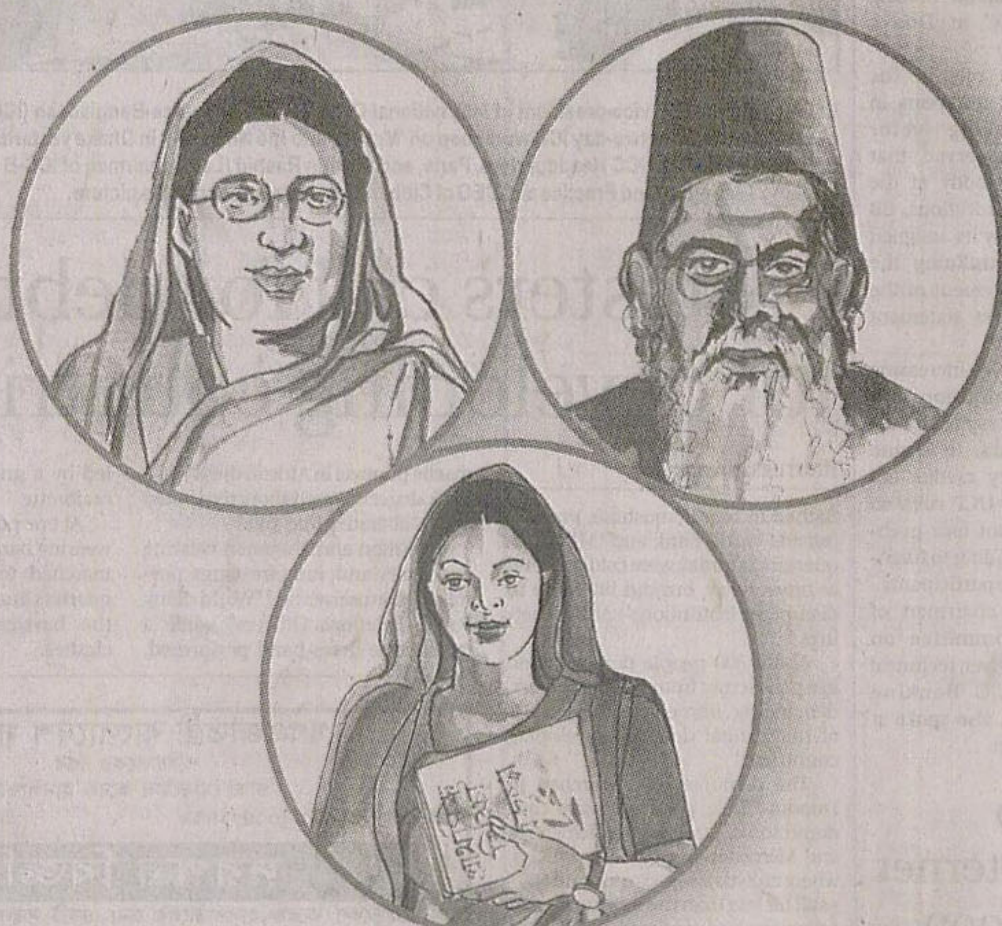

THE ROLE OF LOCAL INSTITUTIONS, ORGANIZATIONS AND COMMUNITIES FOR SUCCESSFULLY IMPLEMENTING ROSC PROJECT

Center Management Committee (CMC):

CMC is the committee comprising of the people of the community, local representatives, educational institutions, teachers, parents/guardians of the students to maintain the quality education and manage the learning centers.

The requirement for forming CMC:

- The main rationale behind establishing the CMC is enhancing the community involvement
- It works to improve the quality education and coverage of services in remote areas
- Ensure the active involvement of communities in meaningful responsibilities and monetary decisions
- It will work towards the empowerment of the community

The roles and the responsibilities of Center Management Committee (CMC):

- CMC will mainly be responsible for running the learning centers. Their main role will be-
- The ESPs appointed by the CMCs will lead community mobilization efforts to identify the target population
- Select ESPs and ERPs and monitor their responsibilities
- Encourage local community to start a school
- Help to organize the appropriate LCs and support quality improvement of the LCs

- Seek assistance from Education Resource Providers (ERPs)
- Monitor the smooth operation of the LCs, especially student and teacher attendance

The CMC will hold the total responsibility of the Learning Centers (LC). ROSC project will disburse money to the bank account of respective CMCs of eligible Learning Centers twice a year. A part of the grant will be used by the Center Management Committee (CMC) for improvement of the Learning Center and the rest will spend for teachers' honorarium, maintenance of learning centres, sanitation, safe drinking water and other educational expenses.

Education Service Provider (ESP)

The ESP appointed by the CMC will lead community mobilization efforts to identify the target population, encourage it to start a Learning Center and help to organize the appropriate LC.

Role of The ESP

- ESP is involved in community mobilization to provide continuous support to CMC in LC management of various activities including:
- Identify the location and/or facilitate to set up new LCs and/or increase capacity of existing LCs
- Identification, selection and appointment of teachers
- Proper identification and selection of ERPs for overall quality education
- Ensure the training of teachers and the availability of materials for quality education
- Identify the hard to reach/out-of-school children and to monitor student attendance

Criteria for selecting ESP

- CMC will select ESP which meet the following criteria:
- A registered NGO or other organization with preferably 5 years experience in working with the respective community
- At least three years experience in the area of education

Education Allowance rate

ROSC Project Learning Center

- Grade 1 - 3: Total Tk. 800 including Tk. 50 monthly and for uniform Tk. 200 once yearly
- Grade 4 - 5: Total Tk. 970 including Tk. 60 monthly and for uniform Tk. 250 once yearly

SKT School

- Grade 1 - 5: Highest Tk. 1250 per student yearly

Education grant

The Learning Centers providing Education Allowance

- Grade 1 - 3: Highest Tk. 25,700 per center yearly
- Grade 4 - 5: Highest Tk. 30,950 per center yearly

The Learning Centers not providing Education Allowance

- Grade 1 - 3: Highest Tk. 55,000 per center yearly
- Grade 4 - 5: Highest Tk. 65,000 per center yearly

SKT School

- Grade 1 - 5: Highest Tk. 25,000-30,000 per school yearly

Timetable for distribution of Education Allowances/ Grants

Twice yearly: 1st installment in March/ April and 2nd installment in September/ October will be distributed through the related bank accounts.
