1. Field Officer- Food (42 positions)

Location: Barisal, Bhola and Patuakhali districts of Barisal Division

The Field Officer, Food is responsible and accountable for receiving food (wheat, peas and vegetable oil) from SC warehouses, storing it at the distribution point and distributing the same to the program participants as per approved ration size.

- Willingness and ability to travel in remote areas. Willingness to ride motorcycle if required.

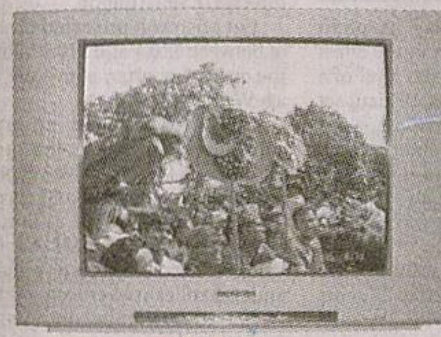
