## 3 killed in city road accidents

Three people were killed in separate road accidents in the city yesterday.

Abdul Motalab,45, a security guard of a rolling mill at Shyampur, was run over by a speeding truck near Uzala Match Factory at 6.00am when he was returning home from his place of work.

Locals rushed him to Dhaka Medical College Hospital (DMCH) where doctors declared him dead.

An unidentified man aged about 60 was killed when a passenger bus hit him when he was crossing the road near Kamalapur Railway Station at 5.00am.

Police said he died on the spot. In the other accident, a youth named Ripon, 22, was killed, DMCH morgue sources said but could not give details.

Two unidentified pedestrians brought Ripon to the DMCH at 8.00am saying only that he was killed in a road accident, sources
