

DMCH assures new recruits of salary 1,301 more held

Dhaka Medical College Hospital (DMCH) authorities yesterday assured the class four employees of paying their salaries by June 30.

A total of 247 newly appointed class four employees held a rally yesterday demanding their salaries.

Earlier, leaders of the DMCH Class Four Employees' Union

expressed solidarity with the movement of new recruits and threatened to go for tougher agitation if their salaries were not paid by June 30. One new recruit said they are yet to receive any salary since joining the service in November last year.

On the other hand, the authorities paid one month's salary to 76 employees on Saturday in the face of their agitation.

During the period, the law enforcers also recovered five firearms, another one weapon and eight bullets and also filed five cases against seven people under the Arms Act.

3 killed in city road accidents

Three people were killed in separate road accidents in the city yesterday. Abdul Motalab, 45, a security guard of a rolling mill at Shyampur, was run over by a speeding truck near Uzala Match Factory at 6:00am when he was returning home from his place of work.

Locals rushed him to Dhaka Medical College Hospital (DMCH) where doctors declared him dead.

An unidentified man aged about 60 was killed when a passenger bus hit him when he was crossing the road near Kamalapur Railway Station at 5:00am.

Police said he died on the spot. In the other accident, a youth named Ripon, 22, was killed, DMCH morgue sources said but could not give details.

Two unidentified pedestrians brought Ripon to the DMCH at 8:00am saying only that he was killed in a road accident, sources added.
