

Six people were killed in separate road accidents in Narayanganj, Faridpur and Panchagarh yesterday.

Our Narayanganj correspondent adds: Three day labourers were run over by a speedy truck on Dhaka-Sylhet highway near Bagmari of Araihazarthana.

They were identified as Idhu, 45, Delwar, 28, and Ahidul,38, who hailed from Satgram union of Araihazar.

Witnesses said the labourers died on the spot when the driver of Narshingdi-bound bus from Dhaka lost control of the steering and ran over them before falling into a roadside ditch. They were going to Purinda on foot in search of jobs, sources said.
