# China urges US to rethink textile curbs, threatens further WTO action

here, Japanese officials said. The agreement was reached when Japanese Foreign Minister Nobutaka Machimura held talks here with Indonesian Coordinating Minister for the Economy Aburizal Bakrie, the officials said.

The Indonesian president is scheduled to arrive here on May 31 on a four-day visit for talks with Japanese Prime Minister Junichiro Koizumi. Machimura and Bakrie agreed

that the two countries would continue preparations to produce a "concrete result" during the president's visit in regard to talks on a free trade agreement, the officials said.

The two countries will also discuss ways to strengthen bilateral economic ties and improve the environment for mutual investment. the officials said.
