# JCD men run riot again

100 hurt, bomb blasts near rally at DU, 3 probe body members resign; exams postponed

Pro-BNP Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal (JCD) activists ran riot on Dhaka University (DU) campus again for the second day on trot, assaulting workers of all the oppositionbacked student organisations after a bomb went off near the JCD rally, wounding at least 100 yesterday.

The new assault prompted seven opposition-backed student organisations led by pro-Awami League Bangladesh Chhatra League (BCL) to call a countrywide student strike for tomorrow in protest.

### 15 hurt in fire at chemicals depot

STAFF CORRESPONDENT

At least 15 people including 10 firefighters were injured, two critically, in a fire that broke out in a chemicals depot at Dayaganj in the capital yesterday.

Firefighters or the owners of the chemical company could not ascertain the origin of the fire.

The depot on the ground floor of a three-storeyed building of Nazma Chemical Works on Jelepara Lane caught fire at around 5:30am and engulfed the adjacent buildings.

Containers full of chemicals, rubber and chemical oil exploded one after another during the inci-dent, causing panic in the densely populated area.

Forty-eight large and 40 small drums of shoe solution and 40 containers of chemical oil were burnt, said Ruhul Amin, assistant SEE PAGE 15 COL 8

## 11 killed in Pak riot

US fast food outlet torched after Shia mosque blast

Six workers of the US fast food chain KFC died when a restaurant was torched by a mob protesting the suicide bombing of a mosque in the Pakistani city of Karachi that killed five others, police said yesterday.

Monday's attack on the minority Shiite mosque in a middle-class neighbourhood and the ensuing riots have triggered fears that a new wave of sectarian violence might spread across the volatile Islamic

### OC closed for highway robbery link

Officer-in-Charge (OC) of Sitakunda Police Station in the district was closed on charge of involvement with highway robbery on Monday.

The OC, Quamrul Hasan, was closed and sent to the district police headquarters in Halishahar at the directive of the higher authorities following Rapid Action Battalion's (Rab) informing the police headquarters of the OC's alleged involvement with the crime.

## 3 killed in 'encounters' with Rab, police

A Jubo League leader and two alleged criminals, including a robber reportedly close to a minister, were killed in three incidents of shooting involving law enforcers in

Dhaka and Rajshahi yesterday. Rab (Rapid Action Battalion) identified Abul Kalam Azad alias Sumon, 22, the Jubo League leader, as a notorious criminal.

The other two who died in yesterday's 'encounters' were Saidur Rahman, 35, and Badjuzzaman Buddu, 34.

A Rab press release said one of their patrol teams went to road No. 4 of Block F in Bansree Project at around 3:30am on information that a gang of criminals had assembled there to

As soon as they reached the area, the gang opened fire on them, prompting the Rab men to return

After the criminals fled the scene, the Rab team found bullet-riddled body of a criminal and a revolver loaded with two bullets.

Khilgaon police later identified

him as Sumon alias Goailya Sumon

of East Goran, the press release said. Sumon was the acting joint convenor of ward No 25 unit Jubo League, the youth front of the main opposition Awami League (AL).

Witnesses and Sumon's family members said Rab arrested him at a cable operator's office in Goran at around 8:30pm Monday. A local ward commissioner runs the office.

Sumon's father Abdul Hakim later found him sitting in a Rab jeep parked inside Rab-3 office at Tikatuli at about 2:30am yesterday.

## Rab's 'shootout' claim shrouded in questions

Rapid Action Battalion (Rab) claimed that Jubo League leader Abul Kalam Azad Sumon was killed in a "shootout" in Rampura early yesterday but witnesses and other sources said he was killed in Rab custody for mistaken identity.

The sources also said there were no proof of Sumon's involvement in criminal activities and his addresses mentioned in the charge-sheets of two cases were full of discrepancies that raise questions about the Rab allegation

A Rab press release dubbed Sumon as notorious "Goailya Sumon" saying he was accused of murdering one Fazlu at Bhuiyanpara in Khilgaon and slaughtering one Belait near Goran Shahi Masjid in the same area.

But the officer-in-charge (OC) of Khilgaon Police Station told The Daily Star that there was no case against Sumon in the police station.

Sabujbagh police said "Goailya Sumon" is accused in three cases including one for murder. The cases are 62/6/96 (murder), 20/1/97 (rape) and 21/1/97 (theft)
