Brazil striker Robinho has been a hot topic of conversation in football circles n the run-up to the South American

World Cup qualifiers during the next week

The 21-year-old Santos striker is reportedly about to be snapped up by Real Madrid as Brazil coach Carlos Alberto Parreira considers whether to field him in matches against Paraguay on Sunday and Argentina on June 8.

Superstar Ronaldo is to miss the qualifiers plus June's Confederations Cup, leaving the way open for a possible inclusion for Robinho.

Brazil are second in the 10nation South American group with 24 points from 13 games, and four points behind leaders Argentina Ecuador are third with 20 points and Paraguay fourth with 19.

The Real Madrid and 2002 World Cup winning striker Ronaldo asked Parreira to be left out because of the recent separation from his fiancee Daniella Cicarelli.

The squad are training at Granja de Comary, near Teresopolis, 120km north west of Rio for their matches against Paraguay at Porto Algere and Argentina in Buenos Aires.

Inter Milan striker Adriano. Ricardo Oliveira and Robinho appear to be competing for the two strikers' places even though Robinho does not have a lot of experience at top international level. Parreira said at their training camp: "Robinho has grown a lot, is

very mature and is a good option for us. Adriano meanwhile realises that Ronaldo's absence gives him the chance to make himself an auto-

matic first-choice player. "I must take advantage to ensure my place in the squad for the World Cup finals. I am going to do everything I


