The changing colours of Ragamala

dancing prince with his flute, wearing a regal attire and a glittering crown, is accompanied by three colourfully clad beautiful ladies. One of them plays on the drum, the other plays a cymbal to the rhythm, while the third boisterously engages in sprinkling colours at the others as a part of Holi, the festival of colours. Flowers and tender leaves are found all around to complement the dancing foursome. This is just the visualisation of Raga Vasant, which depicts all the shades of joy that colour the wind. By following the raga versions created by the poets, the painters visualised them on canvases and created the genre called Ragamala paintings.

The display of a few reprints of the miniature Ragamala paintings and a splendid keynote presentation on it with a slide show by Dr Karunamaya Goswami, captivated the audience at the Indian Cultural Centre on June 3. Organised by the High Commission of India, the programme also featured a classical soiree by Kalpana Bhattacharva.

"Rabindranath Tagore on many occasions pointed out to one of the basic traits of the Indian mind--as what philosophers would term as a continuous move from form to formlessness and then again from formlessness to form. This observation proves to be amazingly true when we view Ragamala paintings, which are visual interpretations of the ragas commonly inherited by the Indian classical music genres: Hindustani (Northern) and Carnatic (Southern)," said Karunamaya Goswami.

In Ragamala paintings sounds are interpreted through shapes. As Goswami explained, "Painting schools to interpret sounds on canvas in colours developed in India over several hundred years." Goswami used the terms ragachitra, and raga icon interchangeably with Ragamala in an amazing attempt at fusing a fine art with performing arts.

Entranced by the lure of Ragamala paintings Goswami said, "This is almost a cosmos in miniature. When you look into it you have the sensation of penetrat-

"The earliest extant Ragamala paintings which are illustrations in a palm-leaf manuscript of the Kalpasutra are found in the Jain tradition. The Ragamala painting genre flourished in different regions in India. Although most of the paintings are largely drawn from the Radha-Krishna story, they have also absorbed all the traditions from Hinduism, Islam, Jainism and others and developed a secular entity. Ragamala paintings are unique

auditory art which continuously flourished in different schools over 500 years, such as Moghul, Rajput, Kangra, Murshidabad, Bijapur and others.

"Today this genre of art enjoys the status of glorious World Heritage Property. Great care should be taken about their preservation.

After the discussion, Agra-Atrauli gharana singer Kalpana Bhattacharya rendered a few ragas with her stylised voice. Started with a Bandish on Bhairav depicting the devotion towards God, she also performed a few other ragas such as Ramkeli, Gunkeli, Ashavari, Dhaneshri and others. With the rendition of each song, the related paintings were projected on the back-screen, making this art more comprehensible to the audience.

Above all, the audience was charmed by the unique

presentation of the programme.

Closely associated with the organisation, Shahin travelled throughout the border areas of Bangladesh to inspire the freedom fighters in different camps through the weapon of spirited music.
