World Cup champions Brazil face arch rivals Argentina on Wednesday night in a winner-takes-all clash with the victors

Fans spent the night of Sunday to Monday outside River Plate's Monumental stadium hoping to buy tickets with a queue that extended two kilometres and that was eight-

Argentina, in the shadow of Brazil, who have won two out of three World Cup finals during the

Brazil coach Carlos Alberto Parreira told the Brazilian press: "It's not something that you can put into words. Let's be clear though, it's a rivalry that is limited to football and doesn't extend to politics or culture. "Argentinians don't hate Brazilians or vice-versa.

The Uruguayan referee of the fixture, Gustavo Mendez, hoped the clash would inspire a party spirit rather than a warlike attitude. He told Clarin.com: "The term war does not correspond to a wonderful sport such as soccer. I hope it is more of a celebration than a war."

# Atletico turn to Bianchi

Atletico Madrid have appointed former Boca Juniors chief Carlos Bianchi as their coach for the next two seasons, the Primera Liga side said on Tuesday.

The 56-year-old Argentine, who has been out of the game since he guit Boca in July last year, takes over from Cesar Ferrando who was sacked last week.

on his arrival from Kolkata yesterday. The East Bengal Striker, originally linked to play for Dhaka Mohal

finally signed for Muktijoddha to play in the ongoing Premier Football League.

His departure came after after the club finished a disappointing 11th place in the league. Bianchi led Boca out of mid-table

obscurity to become the dominant force in South American football, steering them to three victories in the Libertadores Cup and two World Club Cups while he was at the club.

A prolific striker in his playing days, Bianchi turned down the chance to coach the Argentine national team last September and the job was eventually

given to Jose Pekerman.

Although one of the most successful coaches in South America. he has enioved little fortune in his previous coaching jobs in Europe

Aformer striker with Velez and Paris St Germain in the 1970s, Bianchi began his coaching career in France in Reims. Nice and third division Paris FC.

He joined Velez in 1993 and made an immediate impact as he led one of the lesser Buenos Aires clubs to three domestic titles, the Libertadores and the World Club Cup in the space of four years.

## Glazer's sons join MU board

Manchester United said on Tuesday that non-executive chairman Roy Gardner and two non-executive directors had resigned from the board of the world's richest football club following

The US tycoon's three sons were meanwhile appointed to the board, it said in a statement to the London

"Following the unconditional mandatory cash offer for Manchester United... Roy Gardner, the nonexecutive chairman of Manchester United, and Ian Much and Jim O'Neill, both non-executive directors of Manchester United, have each resigned," it added. The English Premiership club also announced the appointment of Joel, Avram and Bryan Glazer and the re-appointment of its commercial director.

"Manchester United is pleased to ment of Joel Glazer, Avram Glazer and

Manchester United's board later caved in to Glazer after agreeing to sell its minority stake to the 76-year-old owner of NFL franchise Tampa Bay Buccaneers.

Minority shareholders in the Premiership team have until June 13 to accept Glazer's unconditional offer valuing the club at 790.3 million pounds (1.16 billion euros, 1.47 billion dollars).
