Elite crime-busters Rab yesterday retrieved an anti-personnel hand grenade from a village in Savar on the outskirts of the capital.

Manufactured in 2001, the grenade is of Arges group, similar to those exploded at the Awami League rally on Bangabandhu Avenue in Dhaka and Hazrat Shahjalal Shrine in Sylhet last year and others retrieved from Kuril Badda in 2003.
