It was a combined decision on late Monday night taken by coach Day Whatmore and skipper Habibul Bashar that surprised those who thought that Bangladesh in all probability would retain the same side that turned the

world upside down with a fivewicket triumph over Australia in Cardiff on Saturday.

Whatmore, however, gave some food for thought to reporters at a press briefing on Monday when he said that he named the 13 probables for the rematch against England with Shahriar Nafees coming into the reckoning at the expense of all-

rounder Khaled Mahmud. A last-minute change is nothing new and Whatmore quite rightly decided to include Tapash Baisya against Australia after seeing the wicket at Sophia Gardens. But the manner in which Whatmore and rest of the team management played on the nerves of the reporters and to some extent with Nafees Iqbal, was unexpected to say the

Nafees Iqbal has certainly lacked confidence throughout the tour and Whatmore could have avoided the drama before making a decision because this particular change has little to do with the nature of the wicket or the condi-
