

Fresh drive to nab outlaws in Khulna

Police on Monday night launched a 'special combing operation' in outlaw infested upazilas of Dumuria, Paikgacha, Koira, Rupsha and Batiaghata in Khulna district.

According to Khulna Police Superintendent, the 'special operation' has been launched following information from intelligence agencies that 'extremists' who fled to India have started returning and are trying to regroup to carry out destructive activities.

The police super admitted that underground parties have again become active in several south western districts including Khulna.

People of 10 villages in Purbadhalia upazila in Netrakona district have voluntarily built a bridge on Ujjajuri canal as all appeals for this made earlier to public representatives and government officials failed.

The 90 feet wooden bridge erected on 16 RCC pillars was opened by village elders. No public representative was present. Students from schools in the upazila joined the simple the opening function, saying their hurdles in going to school in the wet season has now been removed.

The bridge cost about Tk two lakh, arranged from donations by villagers. The earth work was also done voluntarily.

Talking to this correspondent, 75 year-old Abdul Wahed of Bilkawi village said the Netrakona-Kishoreganj road was built during the British period. Every year local people used to erect a makeshift bamboo bridge on Ujjajuri, which collapsed after some days. So, during full monsoon, people had to cross the Ujjajuri either on boats or swimming.

Repeated appeals were made to public representatives, but to no effect, he said. So villagers decided to build the bridge voluntarily.

10 Khulna shrimp units get 'final warning' from EU

The European Union has given 'final warning' to 10 shrimp processing factories in Khulna against 'any more foul play' in export as complaints of 'underweight and presence of germs and unacceptable things' in packed shrimp were found earlier from European buyers.

Owners of the 10 factories received the warning in the last week of May, sources in Khulna Unit of Bangladesh Frozen Food Exporters' Association told this correspondent yesterday.

Existence of antibiotic germ identified as 'Nitrofuran' and 'other objects' were found in packed shrimps, they said. Nitrofuran germ is detrimental to health, they said.

When contacted, Deputy Director of Fish Inspection and Quality Control Directorate Ashraf Ali said EU the warning does not mean suspension of export. These 10 shrimp processing factories should be more careful in buying shrimps from farms and their processing, he said.

When contacted, owners of six of

the processing factories facing the EU warning denied the allegations, saying they take maximum care in exporting processed shrimp and gives top priority to reputation of the country.

Frozen shrimp export from Khulna region fetched Tk 16,000 crore in foreign exchange during 2004-05 financial year, said Kazi Belayet Hossain, vice-president of BFEEA.

Meanwhile, 27 shrimp depots in Kaira upazila in Khulna were sealed by officials of Khulna Fisheries Department on June 18 on ground of violating guidelines for quality control.

Besides, Scientific Officer at the Dhaka head office of Fish Inspection and Quality Control Directorate Mohammad Mokammel Hossain has directed its Deputy Director to take necessary action against four shrimp processing factories in Khulna for not complying with EU guidelines of export.

JCD leader held for extortion in AL leader's name

Vice-president of Khalishpur Mohsin College unit of Jatiyatabdali Chatra Dal, Shahed Ahmed, was arrested on Monday when he was went to Dr Mujahidul Islam to realise a toll of Tk 20,000 he had demanded in the name of Khulna city Awami League Secretary Aliaj Mizanur Rahman.

Dr Mujahidul Islam is proprietor of Khalishpur Clinic.

According to police, the JCD leader phoned the physician several times on Sunday for the toll, saying he was talking on behalf of the Awami League leader.

When Dr Mujahidul contacted, AL leader Mizanur Rahman, he denied having demanded the toll and asked the doctor to take police help.

A case was filed against the JCD leader with Dr Mujahidul as the complainant.

Meanwhile, Khulna city and district units of Awami League issued a joint statement yesterday strongly condemning the incident. Ruling party cadres are now out to tarnish the image of Awami League leaders in such notorious ways, the AL leaders said.

The joint statement was signed by district AL President Shaikh Harun-ar-Rashid, secretary Mostafa Rashidi Shuja and city president Talukder Abdul Khaled MP.

When contacted, Khulna city BNP secretary Nazrul Islam Manju said, "We are not going to take any responsibility at party level for the crime committed by JCD leader Shahed Ahmed. Law will take its own course".

It was gathered that contractor Abdul Gafoor, who was given the work in Kholshabunia, gave the work to one Sohrab Hossain on subcontract at a cost of Tk 1,48,157; contractor Tuhin in Sora appointed one Wahiduzzaman as sub-contractor to finish the work with Tk 349,266 while contractor Bazlur Rahman in Kalibari appointed one Abdul Hamid as sub-contractor to complete his work at a cost of Tk 1,30,000.

On contact, Sohrab, Wahiduzzaman and Abdul Hamid acknowledged doing the works on subcontract.

More 107 bags of VGD wheat seized in Nilphamari

One hundred and seven bags of WFP wheat meant for distribution under Vulnerable Group Feeding (VGD) programme were recovered from a godown owned by a local Awami League leader and his two brothers in Jaldhaka.

A case has been filed against the AL leader's elder brother Zahurul Haque Montu and their business partner Mohsin Ali. But none were arrested till yesterday, police and food officials said. The case was filed under sections 406, 417, 424 and 426, they said.

Lipon, younger brother of the AL leader, was arrested from the spot during the recovery but released within two hours.

Jaldhaka Project Implementation Officer Anwarul Islam told this correspondent that the VGD wheat was meant for distribution among cardholders in Balagram union on 19 June.

The Assistant Field Officer of WFP Rangpur Region Salma Yasmin came to Jaldhaka to monitor the distribution. At one stage she noticed that some rickshaw vans with bags of VGD wheat were coming towards Jaldhaka from Balagram area.

She secretly kept a watchful eye and found that the bags were brought from a godown at Dalia Road in Jaldhaka municipal area. She informed Jaldhaka police who raided the godown and seized 107 bags of VGD wheat and arrested

Lipon, brother of Jaldhaka AL president Ansar Ali Montu.

She then brought the matter to the notice of Nilphamari Deputy Commissioner and the Police Superintendent.

Police recorded a case, filed by Project Implementation Officer Anwarul Islam.

But the local AL president and his younger brother Lipon have been exempted from the case for unknown reasons.

There has been no WFP food distribution under VGD programme in the upazila since the incident, sources said. There are 2,216 VGD cardholders in Jaldhaka upazila. Talking to this correspondent, many cardholders alleged that they got VGD food grains only three times in six months from January to June though it is supposed to be distributed monthly.

A cardholder should get 30 kg per month but they alleged that they got 25 kg per card.

Earlier in March, WFP Assistant Field officer Salma Yasmin recovered about 100 bags of VGD wheat from another godown in Ananda Babur Pool area in Nilphamari town. The wheat was kept there for sale in the black market, police said.

WFP wheat distribution in Nilphamari Sadar upazila is suspended since the incident. A probe body formed at the directive of food ministry is investigating the matter. Its report of is still to reach Nilphamari, official sources said.
