
HE young boy in a rocky relationship with an aging woman in Kanamachhi Bho Bho or the youngest son of the family struggling hard to get married in drama serial Ebong Bive or the long haired boy who does the salsa in a commercial of a soft drink -- are diverse characters played successfully by Shahed Sharif Khan, widely known as Shahed.

Shahed was involved with the theatre group Shubochon in 1993 but he guit the group a year later. In 1999, he got an offer for a television commercial of a ballpoint pen, through which he stepped into the entertainment world. In time, he became a popular face on TV through numerous commercials

Meanwhile director Ringo asked him to act in the telefilm Swapno. The offer came as a surprise to Shahed, as he only had theatre experience. But Ringo had faith in Shahed and said, "You have a good voice and you have the potential to be a TV actor." So Shahed gave the telefilm a try and it was a breakthrough for him.

Soon Shahed got some other offers from makers Arun Chowdhury, Ringo, Ananta Hira and Arif Khan including Ariana and Kanamachhi Bho Bho. But Shahed says, "So far I think my best performance was Sparsher Nayto Mon, directed by Akhtar Ferdous Rana and written by

Mohan Khan. I was gratified with my performance in Shubhadrishti by Rabindranath Tagore as well."



"An actor must do his homework"

Shahed has worked in a couple of feature films including Jayjatra, Juddher Phul, Hridoy Shudhu Tomar Jonno and Priyo

Hassan and Azizul Hakim were the most prominent names. It was quite difficult for any new comer to make room amongst these actors. Competition among the actors was also prevailing, as BTV was

the only TV channel then." About the basic qualities of an actor, Shahed says, "An actor must do his homework for a better performance in every new production. He must practise to develop his acting skills, work on voice modulation, do physical exercises to stay in shape and meditate to stay in peace with his inner self." On typical television plays,

Shahed says, "Initially the directors contact the performers and brief them on the roles. The directors usually consult the whole script in detail prior to shooting. However, Shahed thinks that the overall scenario is not professional at all. He says, "The basic problem is financial because the sponsors are reluctant to make an investment. Foreign models are being used in commercials only to reduce budget. Not all the directors are skilled even. There must be a code of conduct or a specific policy regarding such productions, which can check all kinds of disarray. According to Shahed, "There

are more opportunities for actors with the increased number of TV channels. However, while the number of productions are increasing, quality is not being assured." He is also emphatic that "There should be some restrictions about the broadcasting of the foreign channels, particularly since Bangladeshi channels are not aired abroad.

In the recent residency programme of Britto, three artists -- Anura Krishantha from Sri Lanka, Malak Helmy from Egypt and Imran Hossain Piplu from Bangladesh -worked together. The results of their work were recently exhibited at the Alliance Francaise gallery.

Anura Krishantha's first theme is love and memory and the second is a stolen wreath. Anura said that in the first case he has two chairs and a table with different designs and patterns that he saw around himself in Dhaka. There is a tiger skin replica, a crown, rickshaw designs. He said that he associates happiness with a home and so he has brought in furniture from a household. "While I've enjoyed myself very much here, I've missed my home which I've tried to depict in the chair and the table. I've tried to combine the colours that I've found here with those found back in Sri Lanka. There was someone I used to know with whom I spoke over this table and things used to see. When I look at these things I recall the people who went with them."

Malak Helmy said, "I took elements from movie posters, designs found in the back of rickshaws and the idealistic heavenly village scenes found at the back of trucks, as they transport things from city to city. I've put them together to make my own movie posters.

"These images are new to me and yet recall the movie posters in Egypt. I see similarities in the culture that is here and what we have in Cairo. In my narrative iconography you can read the simplistic roles that have been dramatised.

first is a woman with a PhD. There is then the president, his wife and her family. This is a romantic notion of a happy family under the mother's wing. In the dancing figure in The age of corruption one gets the other extreme. I have played with the three simplistic roles women are supposed to play. You see me playing the roles, responding to what I've seen around me, here, at the same time. Narrative iconography is a story told to you in a single poster. It is usually used in primitive forms of art and is sometimes also used to get a message across loud and clear. These images are often used as a form of propaganda in ads and movies. I've used my simplified

literal images to tell a story of ideal-"I've put myself in the roles. In the ised desires as a woman. I'm poking

fun. I'm basically having fun with the three roles. I've been here for about four weeks and I've found everything very visually stimulating."

Imran Hossain Piplu from Bangladesh said, "I've made a few toys with feathers, paper and wheels. The toys work with remote control. They stand for people who appear nice and friendly but who have other layers of evil qualities in them. These people put out a nice face to bequile society.'

The results of the residency programme were presented at the exhibition and it was accompanied by photographs of more experimental work that the three had done earlier in Chittagong.

War of the Worlds is out of this world!

In his latest movie War of the Worlds, Steven Spielberg marshals state-of-the-art tools of cinema and computerised imagery to mount eve-popping scenes of destruction. chaos and horror. Exploring the dark side of his old films E.T. The Extra-Terrestrial and Close Encounters of the Third Kind, Spielberg more than does justice to the grandfather of all alien-invasion tales, H.G. Wells' still terrifving novel published in 1898. The real question the film raises is whether post-Sept. 11 audiences are ready to view destruction, chaos and horror as entertainment. Most action films since that

tragedy have involved either comic characters, historic battles or book ancient civilisations. But this movie on intergalactic war, starring Tom Cruise might be too realistic for its own good. The film takes perhaps a little too much glee in its abilities to manufacture mayhem. That being said, the ride is extraordinary. Spielberg and his writers, Josh Friedman and David Koepp, opt to tell the invasion story through the eyes of Tom Cruise's character Ray Ferrier, a blue-collar guy with no plan of action other than the protec-



with envious eyes."

Also the movie's death machines. the so-called Tripods, resemble the 100-foot-tall killing machines envisioned by Wells. And Spielberg's aliens, like Wells', suck blood from living humans for sustenance. This results in a startling image of a surreal, blood-sprayed, ruined landscape that is grotesque and

fascinating at the same time. The main humanising element in the movie is the team of Tom Cruise, as Ray and the young prodigy Dakota Fanning, as Ray's daughter Rachel. They play off the rise and fall of each other's emotions, each trying to coax the other nto a false sense of security when the reality of their situation denies any such notion. If Ray didn't have a child to protect, he probably would be as lost as the mobs that surge haphazardly this way and that. With these two, its not always clear who is the child and who the adult, as the actors continually switch those roles in a juggling act of tense emotions.
