Saarc FMs to meet in Aug

Foreign Ministers from the Saarc (South Asian Association for Regional Cooperation) countries are expected to meet in Pakistan in mid-August, reports Online news agency, according to Hindustan Times

The meeting will discuss the agenda for the 13th Saarc summit to be held in Dhaka in November.

The summit was originally scheduled for January, but was postponed to March due to the ecember 26 tsunami. However


