In fact, he was the only Bangalee actor-director who reigned in the erstwhile West Pakistani film industry.

Rahman-Shabnam were a popular duo at that time. Just after the Liberation he continued his film career in Pakistan. Chahat, Doraha, Lagan are the films he made in Pakistan. Later he returned to Dhaka and renewed his acting career. Milon is his first film after Liberation.
