

BSF returns body of Bangladeshi

Indian Border Security Force (BSF) returned the body of Bangladeshi Youth Shahidul Haque after Company Commander level flag meeting with Bangladesh Rifles (BDR) on Tuesday night.

Shahidul Haque, 20, was shot dead by BSF in the early hours of Tuesday while he was working in the farmland along the Rotani border of Baliadangi upazila of Thakurgaon district.

Later, BSF men took away his body from inside the Bangladesh territory.

BDR and police sources said during the flag meeting Indian police handed over the body to Baliadangi police.

CPB protests fuel price hike

Communist Party of Bangladesh (CPB) President Monjurul Ahsan Khan yesterday said the misrule of BNP-led four-party alliance government is leading the country to darkness.

"When the common people are already in great distress due to flood, erosion, storm and price hike, the government has again increased the fuel price ignoring their sufferings", he alleged.

He urged the people to unite to oust the government.

The CPB chief was addressing a rally at Khilgaon in the city as part of the 10-day-long mass contact programme of the party to make its countrywide agitation on July 30 a success.

Monjurul Ahsan demanded compensation from Niko for the victims of Tengratia blowout and reopening of all closed mills and factories.

Party central leaders Ruhin Hossain Prince, Mahabubul Alam, Ahsan Habib Labloo, and Abdul Jabbar also addressed the rally presided over by Kartik Chakrabarti, general secretary of Motijheel thana unit.

Most of the recommendations made by the jail commission constituted in 80s for improving the conditions in the jails were not implemented for political reasons.

The Law Ministry sources yesterday said the government will hold a national convention on the jail reforms in November aiming to develop the jails' condition as per the recommendations of the jail reform commission.

Law Minister Moudud Ahmed yesterday said the government is gathering information from India, Pakistan, Sri Lanka and Nepal on the reforms of their jails.

He said the government has taken steps to improve the standard of food through increasing budget allocation.

"We have provided televisions, fans, mosquito curtains for the prisoners. We have released a number of poor prisoners from jails by providing legal aids and we are also continuing to do that," he said.

Late President Ziaur Rahman formed the jail commission in 1980 to

improve the condition of the jails. After his death, the subsequent governments did not take any initiative to implement the recommendations.

The present government is working on the recommendations, the sources said.

The government is now working to amend and modify the age-old jail code.

A committee led by State Minister for Home Lutfuzzaman Babar has been working for introducing video linkage in the jails for exempting the prisoners from physical appearance before the courts. Besides, the government will very soon start working to shift Dhaka Central Jail to Keraniganj, the sources said.

Process of land requisition and allocation of budget and its design have already been completed in this regard.

More than 12,000 prisoners are now huddling inhumanly in Dhaka Central Jail with capacity of 2,600 prisoners.

Moudud, also chief of cabinet committee on jail reform, discussed the progress of jail reform activities with Babar at his secretariat office yesterday.
