Six injured as prisoners clash in Dhaka Central Jail

At least six inmates of Dhaka Central Jail were injured, two of them critically, in a clash between two rival groups over drug trade on

Tuesday, according to jail sources. The injured are Amjad (22280/02), Jabbar (16206/98), (27335/05), AI Amin (24283/03) and Siraj Bepari (5570/A).

They are now undergoing treatment at the jail hospital.

According to the sources, the incident took place in the evening when two groups of prisoners, reportedly backed by notorious over the drug trade inside the jail.
