Under the rules of the governing body, the International Cricket Council (ICC), 90 overs a day minimum should be bowled during Tests. But a Pakistan Cricket Board

(PCB) official told Reuters on Tuesday that this would not be possible during the tour which will be held during the Pakistan winter from October 26. Instead the teams must only bowl 83

November and December in Punjab are winter months with bad light and fog normally reducing playing hours and dew problems affecting one-dayers in the evening hours.

"The one-dayers which are being played under lights will start early around 1130 in the morning (instead of 1345) so that we have an early finish," director of PCB cricket operations, Saleem Altaf said.

England play three Tests in Multan. Faisalahad and Lahore in November and four of the five one-davers divided between Rawalpindi and Lahore in

The tourists have also agreed to play a one-dayer in the southern port city of Karachi but rejected a proposal to play a Test there for security rea-

## Pakistan to use neutral umps in Eng ODIs

AFP, Lahore

Pakistan will use two neutral umpires in the one-day matches against England after the International Cricket Council (ICC) allowed them to try out the idea, an official said on Monday.

"Our suggestion that two neutral umpires should be used (in all oneday internationals) instead of the prevailing one was not accepted by the ICC, but they have allowed Pakistan to use two neutral umpires for our England series," Pakistan Cricket Board chairman Shaharvar Khan told reporters.

Currently two neutral umpires officiate in Test matches while one umpire from the home country stands with a neutral umpire in one-day internationals.

World champions Australia retained their place at the top of the latest International Cricket Council (ICC) Test rankings even as Pakistan and Sri Lanka slipped to

their lowest positions. Australia have the highest rating of 133 since the new system of calculation was introduced in June, 2003, and can jump to 138 if Ricky Ponting's men swamp England 5-0 in the ongoing Ashes series, an ICC release said.

Number two England and number three India also improved their ratings in the annual update carried out on Tuesday which cancels out Test series played before August 1, 2002.

England go up three points to 114, but if they were to lose to Australia by 4-1 or 5-0, it would fall back to 111, the release said.

India, who lost three away series in Sri Lanka, South Africa and the West Indies between August 1, 2001 and July 31, 2002, benefit by four points because of the update and takes its rating to

Sri Lanka slip to sixth place from number four and Pakistan slump to seven from five, as South Africa climb to four and New Zealand to
