Gatlin is the man to beat in the 100m after world record holder, Asafa Powell of Jamaica withdrew because of a groin injury which has dogged him since setting the new world mark of 9.77sec in June.

Gatlin has been the dominant sprinter as befits the Olympic champion and is set on emulating greats like Maurice Greene and Donovan Bailey in holding the two titles at the same time.

"To be set alongside such great athletes would be a privilege, but I am not going to anticipate my name being mentioned in the same breath until I do achieve that target." said the 22-vear-old, who was controversially reinstated into the 100m at the US trials after being disqualified in the heats.

If rivals like training partner and Olympic 200m champion Shawn Crawford think that the win in Athens last year has sated his appetite then they will be sorely disappointed.
