Group Exhibition at Gallery Kaya



Innovation of Earth by Monsur Ul Karim

AN exhibition of diversified paintings and sculpture at Gallery Kaya attracted a sizeable number of artists and viewers. On September 2, David Sproule, Canadian High Commissioner, inaugurated 'Shomokal-1', a 10-day group exhibition of the eminent as well as promising artists.

Monsur Ul Karim is the oldest while Bipul Shah is the youngest amongst the 10 participating artists in the group exhibition. Other participants in the group exhibitions are Rokeya Sultana, Kazi Rakib, Tarun Ghosh, Dilara Begum Joly, Towfiqur Rahman, Shishir Bhattacharjee, Mohammed Fakhru Islam and Goutam Chakraborty. Besides painting, mixed media, drawing, three sculptures have been exhibited in the showcase of 63 pieces.

Eminent artist Murtaza Baseer who came to view the exhibition on the inaugural day, said "No one can achieve the supreme knowledge in any art form. I have taken cues from the endeavor of young participants in the exhibition."

Mamoon, another viewer, said, "Diversified art forms have been included in the showcase. But, there is a limitation in the group exhibitions in Bangladesh, as artists have to display many works."

Kazi Rakib said, "All the participants are contemporary and regular. I have displayed one sculpture and five paintings at the exhibition. I have used transparent glass as the medium of my sculpture."

Towfiqur Rahman said, "I have displayed two sculptures and five drawings in the exhibition. The key factor of my sculptures is the importance of 'negative space'. I have created the human figure maintaining the characteristics of the materials used for the sculptures."

Shishir Bhattacharjee is displaying five art pieces in the group exhibition. He said, "Usually I do not work on small papers. For this exhibition I have done so. My satirical works always reflect the contemporary condition of myself as well as the country and I have used vibrant colours in the paintings."

Week-long Vietnam Cultural Festival begins

On the occasion of 60th anniversary of the Socialist Republic of Vietnam, the inaugural ceremony of Vietnam Cultural Week 2005 was held at the National Theatre Auditorium of Shilpakala Academy Saturday last. The Ministry of Cultural Affairs, in cooperation with the Embassy of Vietnam, organised a two-day cultural show as a part of the week-long programme.

Begum Selima Rahman, State Minister for Cultural Affairs formally inaugurated the event. As the chief guest of the programme she said, "Bangladesh and Vietnam have cultural exchange programmes. This helps the enrichment of both the cultures."

Earlier after the welcome speech by the Secretary, Ministry of the Cultural Affairs, Ehsan Shamim NDC, the Ambassador of the Socialist Republic of Vietnam, Ngo Van Hoa delivered his speech. As the special guest of the show, he said, "Vietnam has had diplomatic relations with Bangladesh for 32 years. This is the second time that the Vietnamese cultural delegates have come to visit Bangladesh on the occasion of the National Day of Vietnam. Organising such

programmes will strengthen the relationship between these two countries and widen the multi-faceted cooperation between the countries."

After the discussion session, the Vietnamese artists staged a dazzling cultural show. The programme began with the dance performance with an orchestra titled *Royal Music*

which has been recognised as a world heritage by UNESCO in 2003. Different ethnic and traditional musical instruments were complemented by brightly attired dancers. The dance piece was followed by a modern day lullaby. Several traditional instruments made of bamboo, that included flutes and an instrument similar to a xylophone were used in the performance. The piece was soothing.

Next the visiting artistes played a popular and traditional Bangladeshi tune in string instruments with well deserved applause. The next item, *The Dance of Lodo Girls*, was one of the most fascinating pieces of the show. Lodo is one of the 56 ethnic groups of Vietnam and has a rich culture. Draped in bright yellow tops and skirts, the beautiful Lodo girls presented graceful dances. Wearing red shoes and multi-coloured ornate caps; they performed to a melodious tune that repeats a single word --Leeya.

The team leader rendered a ballad *Waiting for you, my lady* followed by another melodious track. Three girls in black glittering gowns in the chorus accompanied the singer.

Across The Border

Ghulam Ali against remixes

Pakistani singers believe that while Indian performers earn a decent sum by performing live abroad to an enthusiastic Asian community, the same is scarcely true for their counterparts across the border. Even the Kings of Ghazals such as Ghulam Ali and Mehdi Hasan bemoan the lack of opportunities to cater to the demands of their fans. This dismal state of affairs irks Ghulam Ali. "I have had so much love and affection from my fans in India that it seems like home to me but there are too many formalities to go through." Ali is happy about the thawing of Indo-Pak relations but he is a vociferous opponent of the increasing "sleaze in the name of art in music videos."

"I want the remixes banned. They have not only spoil our rich cultural heritage but are a terrible effect on the minds of the youngsters," he maintains. The boom in the remix industry has had repercussions in his country too. True, the videos may not be as "vulgar" but as far as "butchering the creativity of immortal melodies is concerned, they are as bad," he grumbles. He expresses surprise that no serious move has yet been taken by the music industry to stop the "obscurity in music videos



and even some of the lyrics." I would like to do my utmost to help this menace at the earliest," he assured.

Venice rolls out red carpet with martial arts epic

Hong Kong martial arts spectacular *Seven Swords* opened the Venice Film Festival on Wednesday last, underlining the prominence organisers have given Asian cinema this year.

The line-up at the world's oldest cinema competition was slimmed down to just 56 films after organisers came under fire for overloading the 2004 edition.

But directors say they have stayed faithful to the festival's tradition of variety, with offerings that include a retrospective to commemorate 100 years of Chinese cinema and a tribute to Venice's legendary lover Casanova.

Some of Hollywood's biggest stars are expected to grace the Lido's red carpet. George Clooney's black-and-white McCarthy-era film *Goodnight and Good Luck* led the line-up of major pictures vying for the Golden Lion with its premiere on last Thursday.

But the honor of stepping out first on to the pine-fringed, beachside

story of seven unlikely heroes battling to save a village from a mercenary general in the early 17th century.

Tsui, who has said his movie is a homage to Akira Kurosawa's 1954 classic *Seven Samurai*, said the picture was the first in a series of up to six epics.

*Seven Swords* kicks off a series of Asian offerings this year, including Korean director Park Chan-wook's *Sympathy for Lady Vengeance* and Stanley Kwan's *Everlasting Regret*, starring pop diva Sammi Cheng.

European films featured at the 62nd edition of the festival include the latest film from 96-year-old Portuguese director Manoel de Oliveira and movies starring France's Juliette Binoche and Russia's Nikita Mikhalkov.

Italy's filmmakers have three films in competition, vying for the country's first top prize on home soil since 1996. This year's jury is led by production designer Dante Ferretti, who won an Oscar this year for his work on Martin Scorsese's *The Aviator*.
