EU ministers call for global response to oil problem

AFP, Manchester, England

EU finance ministers called on Saturday for a global response to high oil prices, urging producers to invest in future supplies and warning of the risks to economic growth.

"Global problems require global solutions," Britain's finance minister, Gordon Brown, told reporters at the end of two days of informal talks with his European Union counterparts in Manchester, northern England,

He said the ministers had agreed

that the dialogue between major oil producing countries and those that consume it needed to be strengthened in order to increase oil supplies

from the price rise in new capacity. and urged oil companies to increase investment in oil exploration, production, refining capacity and alternative energy sources.

The EU is engaged in dialogue with Russia, Norway and the OPEC cartel of producer nations, and Brown said he spoke to the Saudi Arabian finance minister about developments early on Saturday, increased reporting of oil reserves. but gave no details of their talks.


