3 Indians on 5-day police remand

Three Indian nationals held by the members of Bangladesh Rifles (BDR) on Sunday night from Panchagarh border, are being interrogated by Sadar thana police.

Earlier, they were taken on a five-day remand.

There are possibilities of sending them to the Joint Interrogation Cell (JIC) in Dhaka for further interrogation, sources said.

They were detained by the patrolling BDR jawans from bordering Kahorurhat area under Sadar upazila on Sunday, BDR and police sources said.

BDR filed a case against them and handed them over to Sadar police the same night. They were produced before a court of Panchagarh next

day with a prayer for police remand. The court granted them five-day remand.

The arrested are Mohe Singh, 38, son of Khogen Singh of Naxalbari area in Darjeeling district, Ranjit Roy, 27, son of late Ramani Roy of Shalgara village under Bhaktinagar thana and Biplob Kumar Roy, 26, son of Gopal Chandra Roy of village Nabonagar under Falakata thana of Jalpaiguri district in West Bengal.

Some Bangladeshi and Indian currencies were recovered from their possessions at the time of their arrest, the sources said.

19th SAIC board meet begins Sept 25

The 19th meeting of the Governing Board of Saarc Agricultural Information Centre (SAIC) will begin in Dhaka on September 25.

The inaugural function of the meeting will be held in the conference room of BARC.

The members of the Governing Board of SAIC will participate from the Saarc countries.

The SAIC is the first regional centre established under the Saarc parasol.

State Minister for Agriculture Mirza Fakhrul Islam Alamgir will inaugurate the function as chief guest.

Programme Director, Information and Communication Services, Ministry of Agriculture, Bhutan Ms Pema Lhamo will preside the meeting as chairperson.

During the three-day deliberations, the meeting will consider the activities of SAIC and finalise the programmes and budget provisions for the year 2006.

But it could not start the drive due to some complexities that arose during the distribution of VGF (Vulnerable Group Feeding) cards, ministry sources told the news agency.

Now the operation will begin in the divisional cities on September 25 and in the district towns on October 1. The operation will be a daily affair in the capital while it will continue in other parts of the country on alternate days.

Food ministry sources said some 20,000 army personnel have already been engaged in distributing the VGF cards among the distressed people across the country.

Some 1,000 cards are being distributed in every union, 2,000 cards in every first class municipality, 1,500 in every second class and 1,000 in every third class municipality, said a food ministry official. The card distribution process is nearing completion, he added.

He said the local administration as well as the chairmen and members of the unions concerned were trying to persuade the distributors to issue cards in favour of their chosen people, but the ministry promptly resolved all the problems.

The official also claimed that the distribution of the VGF cards was completely free and fair, and none was deprived.

Meanwhile, an inter-ministerial meeting of the Food Planning and Monitoring Committee (FPMC) yesterday decided to launch village rationing on the sidelines of the VGF and OMS.

Under the village rationing, some 900 cards will be issued to every union and the distressed people will be able to withdraw 12 kgs of rice, paying Tk 4 per kg. This will benefit as many as 50 lakh people.

Food and Disaster Management Minister Chowdhury Kamal Ibne Yusuf chaired the FPMC meeting. LGRD and Cooperatives Minister Abdul Mannan Bhuiyan, Agriculture Minister MK Anwar and State Minister for Finance and Planning Anwarul Kabir Talukder were present.

It was informed at the meeting that some 600 dealers in Dhaka and another 18,000 across the country will be engaged in the sale of about 300,000 metric tons of rice through OMS. A family will be eligible to purchase 3-5 kgs of rice at Tk 14.50 per kg.

Under the VGF programme, 10 kgs of rice will be given against a card. About 120,000 metric tons of rice will be required to carry on the operation until the end of October.

The market-intervention operations of the food ministry will continue until the harvest of aman paddy.

The main objective of the OMS is to stabilise the price of rice during the month of Ramadan.

In the capital, rice will be sold under OMS at some 90 points while two dealers will be appointed in every union across the country.

Army, Rapid Action Battalion (Rab), police personnel, and the monitoring committees, headed by magistrates, will keep close watch on the food distribution operations, officials sources said.
