For the past 15 years -- since 1990 -- I have been coming to Somnath this very day for the 'darshan' of Lord Somnath. A new chapter in Indian politics began when I embarked on the Rath Yatra from here," Advani said.

"This yatra will end only when a grand Ram Temple is built at Ayodhya," he said.

The BJP president, who recently announced to resign from the post in December, side stepped several questions about the current political situation in Gujarat, including those concerning suspended woman MLA Ramilaben Desai.

ME truce in tatters

Israel launches major offensive, over 200 militants detained

Israeli aircraft blasted suspected Palestinian weapons facilities in Gaza yesterday and authorities arrested hundreds of militants in the West Bank, launching an offensive against the Islamic group Hamas after it bombarded Israeli towns with rockets.

Prime Minister Ariel Sharon warned yesterday "all means" would be used to end attacks on Israel. Security officials said the military was preparing for possible artillery attacks and a ground invasion unless the Palestinian Authority or Hamas itself halts the rocket attacks.

The army fired several artillery rounds into empty fields in northern Gaza in preparation for a possible attack, the military said. The firing was intended as a drill to

determine possible coordinates for officials, led by Sharon, approved a future attack and there were no immediate reports of injuries.

The new offensive dubbed "Operation First Rain" dashed hopes that Israel's recently completed Gaza withdrawal would help restart peace talks and left a seven-monthold cease-fire teetering on the brink ofcollapse

The fighting also turned up already intense pressure on Palestinian leader Mahmoud Abbas to confront militants, and weakened Israeli Prime Minister Ariel Sharon as he parries a challenge to his leadership.

The Palestinian news agency WAFA reported Secretary of State Condoleezza Rice called Abbas Saturday evening and urged him to preserve the truce and stop further

"The order is unequivocal. We do not mean a one-off operation. We mean ongoing activity whose aim is to hit the terrorists," Sharon said.

In a further sign the truce was

unravelling, the military arrested 207 wanted Palestinian men in the West Bank overnight, most of them members of the Hamas and Islamic Jihad movements. The military has conducted sweeping arrests of Islamic Jihad militants since the February cease-fire with Palestinians, But this is the first time it has detained large numbers of Hamas members.

Among those arrested were Hassan Yousef and Mohammed Ghazal, two of the most prominent Hamas leaders in the West Bank, Hamas officials said.

Maj. Gen. Yisrael Ziv, the head of military operations, hinted Israel was preparing to resume assassinations of top Hamas leaders, a practice suspended after the February cease-fire. Asked whether the leaders were in danger, he said: "Let them decide for themselves."

Bus collisions kill 45 pilgrims in Pakistan

At least 45 people, mostly pilgrims returning from a Muslim shrine, have been killed in two separate bus collisions in southern Pakistan, police said yesterday.

The victims of one accident late Saturday included students of a medical college who were returning from the shrine of Shahbaz Qalandar, said local police officer Malik Usman.

Their bus ploughed into another bus near the shrine, he said adding that 37 people died and 60 were injured.

Thousands of devotees visit the shrine in the town of Sehwan, 225km north of Karachi, every year to mark the anniversary of the Muslim saint's death.

The vote came after days of haggling at International Atomic Energy Agency headquarters in Vienna that set Russia, China and non-aligned states, which support Iran's right to peaceful nuclear technology, against the EU and the United States, which charge that Iran's civilian nuclear programme is a cover for the secret development of atomic weapons.

At an organisation, which prides itself on consensus decisions that show international unity, the vote was 22-1, with 12 abstentions including Russia and China on the IAEA's 35-nation board of governors, IAEA spokeswoman Melissa Fleming told reporters.

The resolution explicitly states for the first time since the IAEA almost two decades.

A finding of non-compliance is an automatic trigger for taking the matter to the Security Council, which can impose sanctions as it, unlike the IAEA, has enforcement But referral to the Security

Council would come only after a report on Iran by IAEA chief Mohammed ElBaradei, which he will probably make to the next board meeting in November. ElBaradei said the message of the resolution was that there is still
