Ashley Giles has told his England teammates they should prepare themselves for a hard-fought series in Pakistan as they look to build on their Ashes-winning exploits.

Warwickshire left-arm spinner Giles, 32, played a key role in England's 2-1 home Test series win against Australia that gave them the Ashes for the first time in 18 years by helping Michael Vaughan's men retain control in the field while the quicks rested and taking 10 wickets into the bargain.

He also starred with the bat, seeing England to victory in the fourth Test at Trent Bridge and then making a Testbest 59 as the hosts secured a seriesclinching draw on the last day of the final Test at The Oval.

Giles was making his name in international cricket when England last toured Pakistan five years ago, winning the three-match series 1-0 after a dramatic victory in fading light on the final day of the third Test saw them become the first visiting team to win a Test in Karachi.
