Shabnam

Memorable moments in the life of an actress



HABNAM'S passion for acting started in her early teens. At that time she was taking dance lessons at the Bulbul Academy of Fine Arts and that was the only exposure she had to the world of performing arts. "When I joined films, it was indeed a turning point in my life, since very few ladies in the subcontinent were exposed to the silver screen then," she says.

'When director Ehtesham christened me Shabnam, meaning dew drops (Shabnam's original name is Jharna Boshak) and offered me the second lead in his first Urdu film Chanda, it was no doubt a memorable moment. Released in 1962, the film was a big hit at the box office. This was my first Urdu film as well," says Shabnam. Shabnam's immense acting potential fetched her powerful lead roles in films by ace directors of the time

"It was on the sets of Rajdhanir Bukey, Ehtesham's debut film that Robin (Ghosh) and I met for the first time. Ehtesham provided Robin with a break through his Urdu film Chanda; the lead roles of which were played by Rehman and myself." From then on began Robin Ghosh's illustrious career as a music composer, "Soon Chanda became a talk of the town and earned a super hit status. Bangalee folk tunes modified just enough to tantalize the ears, conquered hearts of film enthusiasts. Meanwhile the intimacy between Robin and I developed fast and eventually we decided to get married in 1965. Thus began a new chapter in my life,"--Shabnam.

"While I played the lead role in Aakhri Station in 1965, I enacted the role of a girl who's psychologically imbalanced. I had only one line in the whole film. The scene was like this: I meet the lead male character in the

film, played by Akbar and I tell him, 'Babu ektho biri dey na.' Before I signed the film, my associates and wellwishers repeatedly asked me to think twice before accepting the offer. I was at the peak of my career at that point. According to them, such a role could ruin my career. But till this date, I believe, it was one of the most powerful roles that I have portrayed and it satisfied me as an artiste. And I consider that a turning point in my career. Contrary to what my friends believed, that role got me rave reviews and also my second prestigious Nigar award the same year," gleams Shabnam

The day our only son Ronny was born definitely changed my life altogether. Nothing can be compared to the joy it brought to our lives from that day


Upcoming talent Fariel's World



Fariel Shafee, a Bangladeshi residing in the USA working on her Ph D thesis in Physics, has recently been selected to participate in the Florence Art Biennale. In 2001, the UN recognised the "Florence Biennale" as an official partner in the programme "Dialogue among Nations.

According to family sources, Fariel has been painting ever since she was in Holy Cross School and learned the basics of water colour from Masuma Khan's Art School at Alliance Français. Hamidur Rahman, architect of the Shaheed Minar, is a granduncle and Kalam Mahmood, a very popular cover artist and illustrator of books of vestervears, is an uncle, though she never had any lessons from either.

After completing both her SSC and HSC as well as O- and A-level studies



with top grades in Bangladesh, Fariel left for the USA in 1994 to work on her Bachelors degree, majoring both in Physics and in Mathematics from MIT. But she also kept painting in her precious little spare time. Later, while a graduate student at Princeton, she started displaying her artwork at a professional level. In 2002, she was invited to display her childhood work at Papaink, the international children's art archive to encourage children to paint. Her shows include one in Greece in a gallery run by wellknown art personality, and also two prestigious juried shows in Spain. She has also exhibited her work in numerous shows in Soho, one of the most artsy districts in the USA. Her artwork has also been published in a number of magazines in the USA. She is fea-

tured as an elite artist on abs gallery

one of the most prominent online international galleries, curated by an Emmy award nominee visual artist. She has also displayed her digital art in New York, and has been accepted as a distinguished computer artist by the Museum of Computer Art.

Fariel's paintings display a wide range of bright colours, reflecting the contrasts in human expectations and desires. Many vivid colours coexist on the same canvas to make the pieces in the painting complementary to each other. Most of her images are derived forms of human figures or abstractions of dream sequences.

Fariel is also involved in a project of popularising Bangladeshi textile and has displayed fashion designs at the official San Francisco fashion week. She has spoken about her art and fashion designs in cable TV shows in Cambridge and Boston.

frequent and one day, she was attacked and dragged away by Monir to a local clubhouse, where Monir proposed to marry her. Kona


declined and after much scuffling, police rescued her from the clubhouse and arrested Monir. However, he is released after a few days on bail.

Twenty-five years after the murder of former Beatle John Lennon, a Canadian-based film company is set to explore the mind of his killer in a movie starring Lindsay Lohan and Jared Leto, backers of the project said last Thursday. Leto, who played a heroin addict in Requiem for a Dream and a

cocaine-snorting arms dealer in Lord of War, has signed on to portray Lennon's killer, Mark David Chapman, in the upcoming $independent film {\it Chapter 27}.$ Lohan, the teenage Mean Girls star last seen in Herbie: Fully

Loaded, will play a fictional Lennon fan who befriends Chapman during the weekend he kills the musician outside his Manhattan apartment building. The parts of Lennon and wife Yoko Ono have not been cast

Peace Arch Entertainment President John Flock, whose

character of Lennon himself would get relatively little screen time as the movie focuses on Chapman in the days leading up to

Chapman, currently serving a prison sentence of 20 years to life, shot Lennon to death outside the Dakota apartment buildon December 8, 1980, hours after getting the former Beatle to $autograph\,a\,copy\,of\,his\,newly\,released\,come back album\,\textit{Double}$ Flock said the title of the film, Chapter 27, is a reference to the

 $26\,\mathrm{chapters}$ in the JD Salinger coming-of-age novel $\mathit{The}\,\mathit{Catcher}$ in the Rye, which Chapman cited as his inspiration for the murder. Chapman has said he identified with the book's hero, who hated phonies, and gunned Lennon down because he thought him a hypocrite. Production on the film, the brainchild of first-time writer and

director Jarrett Schaeffer, is set to begin January 16 2006 in New York, with producers aiming for a commercial release late

Phil Collins open to Genesis reunion

British singer and songwriter Phil Collins said last Sunday that he would be open to a reunion of his old band Genesis, before his performance in Israel, as part of his what he calls his final tour.

"I'm open for it," said Collins, 54, the most prominent international music star to perform in Israel since the start of a Palestinian uprising more than five years ago. "I'm happy to sit behind the drums and let Peter

(Gabriel) be the singer. If (a reunion) happens, I'll be there. If it doesn't happen ... it would just be because there are too many things in the way," Collins told reporters in Tel Aviv. The progressive rock group Genesis was formed in

1967 and was internationally successful for over 30 years. Collins, the band's first drummer, took over as singer after Gabriel quit the group in 1975 to become a

Collins left the band in 1996 to concentrate on his own solo career having already scored solo hits in the

1980s with Against All Odds and In the Air Tonight. After a shuffle of band members, including an Israeli

drummer, Genesis finally called it quits in 1998.
