Govt asked to publish gazette within Nov 21

The Sangbadik-Sramik-Karmachari Oikya Parishad (SSKOP) yesterday asked the government to publish the gazette stating the 40 percent dearness allowance (DA) announcement by the Sixth $Wage\,Board\,within\,November\,21.$

The Sixth Wage Board recommended 40 percent DA on October 2.
