

Sean Connery thinks a blond Bond is just fine. The former 007 says Daniel Craig is a "terrific choice" as the new British superspy. Some eyebrows were raised in

October when producers cast the sandy-haired, relatively unknown Craig in the next James Bond film, Casino Royale. But Connery, 75, told British Broadcasting Corp television that he approved. "Craig's a great choice, really

interesting -- different," Connery said in comments released Friday by the broadcaster. "He's a good actor. It's a completely new departure," he added:

a news conference in October that Connery was his favorite 007. Connery was the first actor to play Bond, appearing in six films


