A Tk 5 crore government programme launched to combat skills Monga in December last year has been stalled due to acute shortage of fund, manpower and mismanagement

The 'Zero Poverty Special Loan Progamme' was launched at the directive of Prime Minister Khaleda sanctioning authority. But the loan was of little help to five lakh

Last year at the time of its launching, it was declared that Tk 5 crore would be disbursed to ultra-poor people during pre-harvest period of 'aman' cultivation season in Bangla month of Aswin and Kartik (mid-September to mid- November). Ultra-poor would be directly benefited as the loan was mortgage-free having minimum interest rate of 5 to 6 per cent and repayable in 48 equal weekly installments

Last year only Tk 27.25 lakh were disbursed but this year not a single paisa was disbursed till now as there is no fund or any loan allotment

Priority was given to provide loan
