রঙানিমুখী তৈরি পোশাক শিল্পের মালিক ভাইদের সদয় দৃষ্টি আকর্ষণ

রঙানিমুখী তৈরি পোশাক শিল্প প্রতিষ্ঠানে অগ্নি-দুর্ঘটনা প্রতিরোধে আমরা বিজিএমইএ'র পরিচালনা পরিষদ অতি সন্তোষিত কিছু জরুরী সিদ্ধান্ত নিয়েছি। এগুলো হলো এখন থেকে-

১। প্রতিটি পোশাক শিল্প প্রতিষ্ঠানে বাধ্যতামূলকভাবে কমপক্ষে দু'টি সিঁড়ি থাকতে হবে এবং কারখানা চলাকালীন সময়ে বাধ্যতামূলকভাবে প্রতিটি সিঁড়ির দরজাই (গেইট) বাঁধামুক্ত অবস্থায় খোলা রাখতে হবে। পোশাক শিল্প প্রতিষ্ঠানে সিঁড়ির দরজা (গেইট) খোলা রাখার বিষয়টি নিশ্চিতকরণের জন্য বিজিএমইএ'র পরিদর্শক দল নিয়মিতভাবে কারখানাগুলো পরিদর্শন করবেন। পরিদর্শনকালে কাজ চলাকালীন অবস্থায় কোন কারখানায় যে কোন একটি সিঁড়ির দরজাও (গেইট) বন্ধ পাওয়া গেলে ঐ কারখানাকে প্রথমবারের জন্য ১০ হাজার টাকা জরিমানা করা হবে। একই কারখানা দ্বিতীয়বার সিঁড়ির দরজা (গেইট) বন্ধ অবস্থায় পাওয়া গেলে ৫০ হাজার টাকা জরিমানা করা হবে এবং তৃতীয়বার একই অবস্থায় পাওয়া গেলে ঐ কারখানার বিজিএমইএ'র সদস্যপদ বাতিল করা হবে।

২। যে সকল কারখানায় কমপক্ষে দু'টি সিঁড়ি (বিকল্প সিঁড়িসহ) নেই, তাদেরকে এই বিজ্ঞপ্তি প্রকাশের পর থেকে ৪৫ দিন সময় দেয়া হবে। এ সময়ের মধ্যে দু'টি সিঁড়ির ব্যবস্থা না করা হলে বিজিএমইএ ঐ সকল কারখানাকে সকল ধরনের সেবা প্রদান বন্ধ করে দেবে।

৩। অগ্নি দুর্ঘটনা প্রতিরোধে অবিলম্বে বাংলাদেশের সকল পোশাক শিল্প প্রতিষ্ঠানে প্রয়োজ্য কমপ্লেক্স কার্যক্রমের অগ্রগতি উদত্তে বিজিএমইএ'র ঢাকা ও চাঁদমাঠের পরিচালকদেরকে নিয়ে গঠিত বিশেষ টিমগুলো আগামী ১ মাসের মধ্যে সকল কারখানা পরিদর্শন করে প্রতিবেদন পেশ করবে এবং সে অনুযায়ী প্রয়োজনীয় ব্যবস্থা গ্রহণ করা হবে।

বিজিএমইএ পরিচালনা পরিষদের গৃহীত উপরোক্ত সিদ্ধান্তসমূহের সফল বাস্তবায়নে আপনাদের ঐকান্তিক সহযোগিতা ও অনুপ্রেরণা আমাদের একান্ত দরকার। একমাত্র আমাদের সকলের ঐক্যবদ্ধ প্রয়াসই এই শিল্পকে আন্তর্জাতিক অঙ্গণে টিকিয়ে রাখতে পারে।

 On Feasibility Study on Prepaid Health Financing Model

Family Planning Association of Bangladesh (FPAB), one of the Member Associates (MA) of International Planned Parenthood Federation (IPPF), under its EC funded "Safe Motherhood project", intends to conduct a study on prepaid health care financing scheme among the population with a representative sample in project areas. The project areas are located at six Upazilas, e.g. Dharmapasha (Sunamgonj), Kaptai (Rangamati), Naniarchar (Rangamati), Rangamati Sadar, Noakhali Sadar and Sylhet Sadar. The objective of study is to look at the purchasing capacity of the target audience with regard to delivery of maternal health and SRH service. It will also look at the feasibility of changing communities behavior towards health services from passive recipient to active purchaser of service. The study is expected to commence from 22nd March 2006 and be completed by 22nd May, 2006.

The Australian Development Scholarships (ADS) are the principal mechanism by which Australia provides scholarship assistance for individuals from developing countries to undertake studies at Australian education institutions. The goal of the scholarships is to help meet the human resource development needs of developing countries. Scholarships also play an important role in fostering and sustaining Australia's relations with developing countries, particularly in the Asia-Pacific region.

 - with a high standard of academic background and have achieved a minimum of 60 per cent average grades in all certificate and/or degree exams (applicants from tribal descent are excluded from this requirement);
 - have no third class results in any examination.
- Nominate only one field of study from the list provided in the website. The field of study can not be changed once you have been short-listed. After you have been short listed you will select the specific subject within your broad study area.
- You should have at least two years of work experience relevant to the field of study you are applying for.

In addition to the above, the short listing process will constitute of the following criteria:

- Fifty percent of scholarships will be awarded to female candidates and fifty percent will be awarded to male candidates.
- In addition, targeted scholarships are available for female and male candidates of tribal descent.
- Preference should be given to candidates who have not previously undertaken post-graduate studies abroad
- Preferences should be given to candidates who are not dual national of an OECD country.
