
Djuice and Pizza Hut jointly organised the concert.

'BNP has expanded education'

Information Minister M Shamsul Islam yesterday said that the BNP expanded education in the country whenever it was in power.

"Earlier, the examination centres across the country were scenes of festival of copying" he said, adding that after coming to power this time, the government stopped stealing in examination halls.

He was speaking as the chief guest at a ceremony organised by Tungibari Upazila administration of Munshiganj district for distributing cheques of government grants for different educational institutions.

Presided over by Tungibari Upazila Nirbahi Officer Mohammad Abdul Hamid Joardar, the function was addressed by Munshiganj Poura BNP President Shahjahan Sikder, Mirkadim Pourasabha chairman Mohammad Hossain Renu, BNP leader Kazi Abdul Jabbar, Kathadia-

Shimulia Union Parishad chairman Delwar Hossain Munshi and headmaster of Dighirpar A C High School, Mosharraf Hossain.

The minister said a party was hatching conspiracy to destabilise the country, but the people are not heeding to their calls as they know BNP is a party of peace, development and progress.

Shamsul Islam said the previous government could not give the country anything, but terrorism, loots and copying in examination halls.
