The Project

Project interventions include:

1. Developing capacity and awareness for improved delivery of justice for women Gender Specialist for Institutional Capacity Building through formal and informal mechanisms in selected districts.
2. Fostering advocacy and dialogue for a stronger normative framework and legislation in the area of women's rights and empowerment
3. Building capacity of MWCA towards policy formulation and planning for women's rights

We are looking for a Project Coordinator (Legal and Social Rights) to be an active member of the project team. The Coordinator will be responsible for delivering results on the first two project components and will report directly to the GTZ Adviser and work in close collaboration with the MWCA Project Director.

- Developing and coordinating programs to support legal and social awareness raising campaigns for women and men, legal advisory and assistance services for women, and identifying gaps and emerging opportunities in legislation and policies for project interventions and multi-stakeholder dialogue
- Facilitating and managing research studies, as required, and liaise with research institutions or consultants
- Managing, evaluating, and monitoring project activities conducted by NGO partners
- Facilitating constant communication with and among various project partners
- Representing the project at meetings, workshops, seminars with other stakeholders for effective dialogue and advocacy of project objectives
