She left behind two sons, four daughters, grand children and host of near and dear ones to mourn her sudden demise.


With a heavy heart we express our deep sorrow at her demise and extend our heartfelt condolence to the bereaved members of her family.

Mobile court seals off Techno Diagnostic Centre

A mobile court yesterday sealed off Techno Diagnostic Centre at Mohammadpur in the city and issued an arrest warrant against its owner as its staff failed to produce DG health certificate and atomic energy commission certificate.

During a drive against unhygienic condition, the mobile court team led by Magistrate Narayan Chandra Debnath found that the centre has no skilled technicians and is using date-expired reagents. The X-ray room is also not encased.

Moreover, chickens and medicines were found in the same fridge.

The team also raided New Capital Diagnostic Complex and Unique Medical Centre in the area and fined them Tk 40,000 and Tk 20,000 respectively for failing to maintain hygiene standards.

New Capital Diagnostic Complex had neither the trade licence nor the atomic energy commission certificate. The team also found 30,000 date-expired syringes in the complex. Its X-ray room was filthy and does not have required equipment.

The Unique Medical Centre

failed to produce atomic energy commission certificate. The centre has no skilled technician and its X-ray room is not encased.

7 held on charge of fraud

Rapid Action Battalion (Rab) yesterday arrested seven members of a gang from the city's posh area Baridhara on charge of fraud.

Rab members also seized Tk 56200, five briefcases and 11 mobile phone sets raiding their residence-cum-office in DOHS.

Rab sources said members of the gang managed to remove around Tk 19 lakh before the raid.

One of the arrestees was identified as Babul while the identities of the rest could not be known immediately.

The brief cases were full of bricks wrapped in paper.

They use bricks so that people think the brief cases are full of money, Rab sources added.

"The gang having 15 to 20 members assures their targets of making huge profits in whatever business they are involved. Once the targets are convinced they take some amount in advance," said Major Hafiz of Rab-1 who led the operation.

"The gang also trapped foreign job seekers assuring them of sending abroad and thus made crores of taka," he added.

The Rab team conducted the raid following information from a man whom the gang assured of providing money for constructing a three-storey building in exchange for Tk 2.5 lakh in advance.

One Haji Jahangir Alam is the leader of the gang.

He was arrested a year back by Rab on charge of fraud, but released on bail later.

Swechchhashebuk Dal expels two

Jatiyatobadi Swechchhashebuk Dal, voluntary front of ruling BNP, yesterday expelled its central Vice President and City Committee President Akhtarruzzaman Akhter and City Committee Joint Secretary Rafiq Hawladar for anti-party activities, says a press release.

Their primary membership has also been cancelled.


