

It's all for a neutral caretaker chief

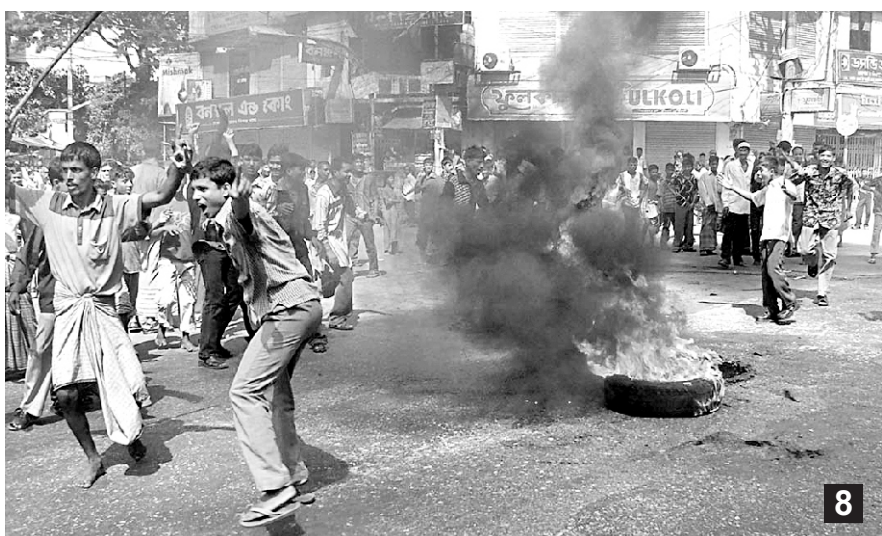
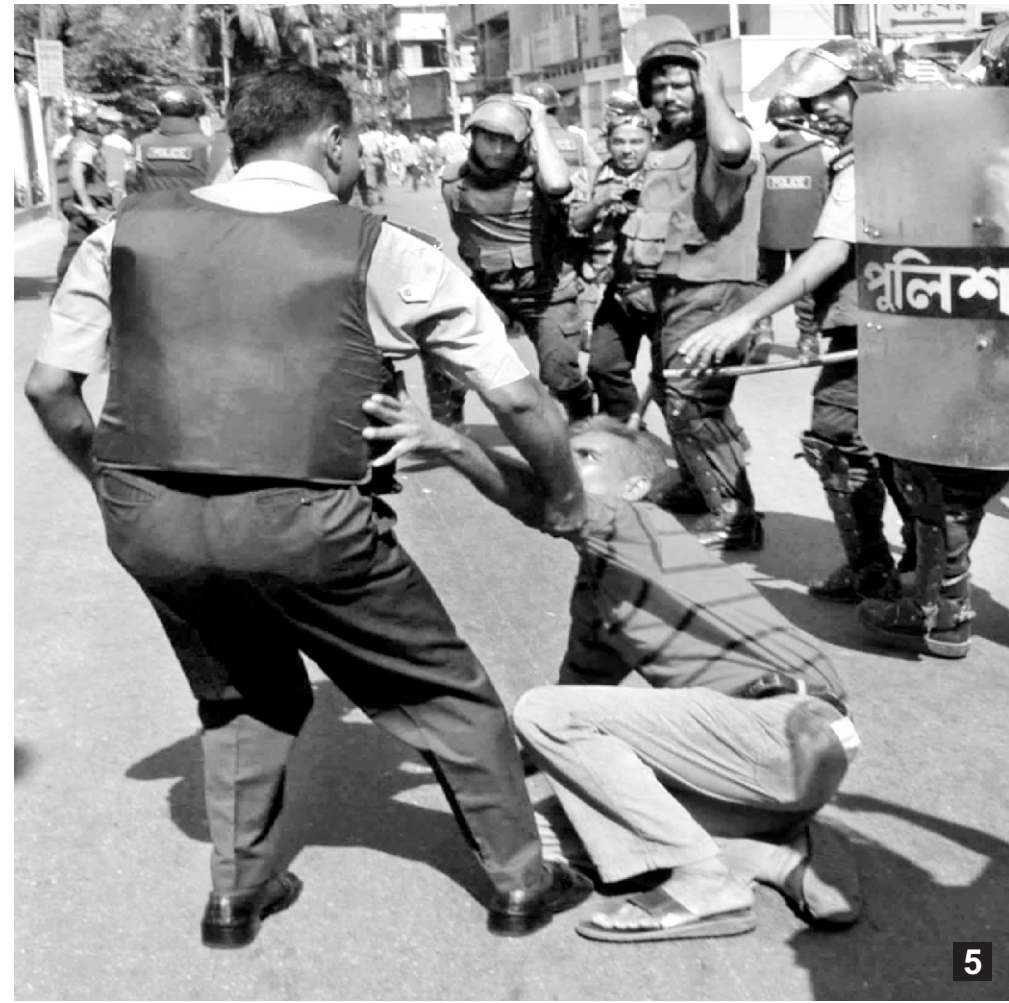
