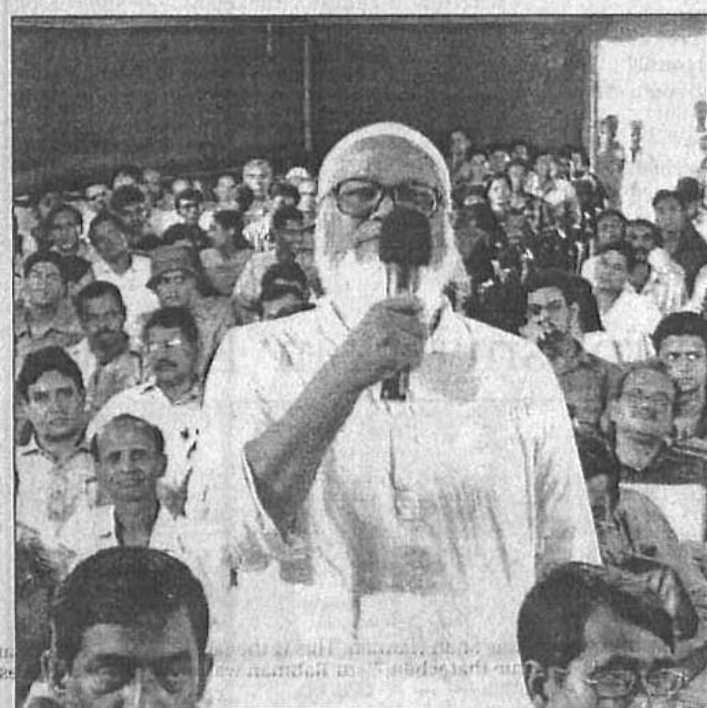
Saidul Haque
