15 RMG workers hurt in boiler blast in N'ganj

At least 15 workers were injured when a boiler exploded in a garment factory at Masdair under Fatullah Police Station yesterday.

Police and witnesses said the boiler exploded with a loud bang at Gazira Garment when the workers were in a shift.

The windowpanes of the garment factory broke and broken glasses hit workers, injuring 15 of them. The loud bang created panic among the workers and they ran to the staircase from third floor triggering a stampede.

Of the injured, Hasan, 15, was rushed to Dhaka Medical College Hospital (DMCH) in a critical condition while others were released after first aid, hospital sources said.
