


Bangladesh in his heart

Photography exhibition on Shamsur Rahman



Hridoy, featuring images of the poet, shot by MA Taher was inaugurated at Bengal Shilpalaya on January 16. Taher, a freelance photographer, was close to the poet and had the opportunity to accompany him at key public events as well as catch glimpses of his casual family life.

Zohra Rahman, widow of the poet, was the chief guest at the event; Professor Zillur Rahman Siddiqui and Professor Kabir Chowdhury were special guests. Among other dignitaries attending the event were artistes Qayum Chowdhury, Ferdousi Priyobhashini and Murtaja Baseer.

Taher prefers themed photographs. His work has appeared in several government and non-government publications, newspapers, calendars and posters. He is the International Affairs Secretary and FIAP liaison officer of Bangladesh Photographic Society.

Taher is a recipient of honourable mention at the BPS Annual Contest (1999), Photography Award, USA (1996-94), 23rd Seikyo International Award, Japan (1993), Certificate of Merit and Young Buddhist Association of Thailand (1992). His solo exhibitions include *Buddhists of Bangladesh* (New York, 1995), *Ruposhi Bangladesh* (New York, 1994), *Life of Visuddhananda Mahathero* (Dhaka) and more.

At the inaugural, the photographer said, "One of Shamsur Rahman's endearing traits was his ability to befriend people.

I was always treated like a family member."

Photographs bring to light not only a Bangladeshi icon but also a family man; a public figure taking a stand against fundamentalists and enjoying solitude. Both black and white and colour photographs are included in the exhibition. As portraits, the black and white images stand out for their obvious aesthetic appeal and display of a photographer's love affair with lights and shadows. Colour photographs document important events in the poet's life.

Images frame the poet with Kalim Sharafi, Professor Kabir Chowdhury, Syed Shamsul Haque and Kamal Lohani at the fourth anniversary of Ghatak Dalaal Nirmul Committee; meeting Ila Mitra and Ramen Mitra at their Kolkata home, receiving his D Lit at Rabindra Bharati University; exercising his rights as a citizen by casting his vote; with his mother and wife.

Professor Zillur Rahman Siddiqui compared the relationship between the poet and Taher to that of Dr Johnson and Boswell. An unmistakable bond between the photographer and his subject -- the poet -- is apparent in the photographs.

The exhibition will continue till January 22.

'Balcony': Of infinity and calm

Sanjib Barua's solo exhibition

Balcony, the first solo exhibition of Sanjib Barua, a young painter from Chittagong, is something to write home about. Inaugurated on Monday last at the Alliance Francaise de Chittagong by Nazlee Laila Mansur amongst a gathering of students, artists, critics and other personalities, this exhibition stands out for the commentary on the artwork heard in the gallery.

However the outside, which is an expanse of uprooted trees, of pieces of the sky visible through a labyrinth of skyscrapers from the balcony, induces the feeling of interpretation. The balcony is portrayed here as a space that opens to the outer world of tranquillity. In the urban jungle, where trees are uprooted and replanted in constricting pots that remain inside or on the periphery of the living space, the balcony is the only way out to infinity and calm.

The theme could be considered both creative and mundane, depending on the quality of inter-

being trapped. Dark colours of the night, interspersed with green for life and red for harsh reality, depicting free movement contained in solid forms, all form a panorama that points together towards obstruction and deprivation. The juxtaposition of dark and light, of green and red build a message that is conveyed in stages, from one tableau to another.

A realistic style containing an element of abstraction, a fine eye for detail and a high level of sensitivity characterise Barua's burgeoning style. The series of paintings and drawings stand witness to tedious research behind the depiction of a clearly enunciated idea. The integrity of thought and of form, the subtle social commentary, the poignant religious symbolism and the obvious aesthetic value of Barua's work deserve a special mention.

Barua graduated with a Masters in Fine Arts from Chittagong University in 2001. He has participated in a few group exhibitions and has received the Best Award in the Berger Young Painters Competition in 2006.

The exhibition ends today.

Drama serial 'Bishokhoy' to be aired tonight

Thirteen-episode drama serial *Bishokhoy* will be telecast tonight at 9:45pm on ntv.

The story line: Musfiq, a PhD in Pharmacy returns to Bangladesh with the intention of serving his country. He dedicates his research activities to find drug addiction repressants. A young woman joins him as his assistant in the project. In course of time, a schism develops between him and his wife. At one point, his wife Shila hires a goon to put an end to the relationship between Musfiq and his assistant.

The serial is written by Masum Reza and directed by Diponkor Dipon, Azizul Hakim, Jitu Ahsan and Chandni are the main cast members of the serial.

Shilpa Shetty faces racist barbs on UK reality show

Shilpa Shetty unwittingly became the symbol of officially multi-cultural Britain's very public, sometimes two-faced, fight against racism (last Tuesday) with at least 4,500 viewers of the reality TV show *Celebrity Big Brother* officially complaining the film star is being victimised and bullied on live TV because she's an 'Indian'.

Ofcom, Britain's official TV watchdog, confirmed late on Tuesday that viewers' complaints said "it's racism pure and simple (against Shetty)".

Appalled viewers across the board white, brown and black have been objecting from Monday evening to Shetty's treatment by white housemates.

This includes one contestant repeatedly referring to Shetty as "the Indian" and refusing to pronounce her name; another alleged to have described her as a "Paki"; a third describing her as a "dog"; a 'girl gang' of three poking fun at her accent and still others making derogatory comments about India's habitual ill-health just because Shetty presented a slightly underdone chicken curry to the inmates of the Big Brother house.

Observers said Shetty, who was initially not in the running to win the show, may now have the bonus of benefiting from the racist bullying and actually stand a chance of winning.

Shetty, who surprised her fans just weeks ago by electing to take part in a reality TV programme that has often been described as vacuous pap, has already bared her soul to millions of Britons by spending much of her time on the show in floods of tears.
