Request for Expression of Interest

Jamuna Multipurpose Bridge Authority under the Ministry of Communications, Government of Bangladesh desires to engage consultants for Consultancy Services for Monitoring of Hydraulic and Morphological Conditions for the Safety of the Jamuna Multipurpose Bridge during the year 2006-2007.

The objective of the Monitoring of Hydraulic and Morphological Conditions study by using 2D-Morphological Model of Jamuna Bridge at Jamuna Bridge Site by using MIKE 21C Modelling Software is to support JMBA in the safe operation and maintenance through advance monitoring of morphological developments and bank erosion in the vicinity of the bridge during monsoon floods. The specific objectives are

Formulating monitoring plan for safe operation and maintenance programme including disaster preparedness

Analysing the hydro-morphological situation at the vicinity of the Jamuna Bridge w.r.t. design considerations of the bridge

- flow velocity along the river training structures
- channel plan-form at the vicinity of the bridge
- bed level evolution along the river training structures
- bank erosion at upstream and downstream of the bridge vicinity etc.

- Assessing the impact of char migration on the river training structures of the bridge;
- Impact of flow pattern change on river training works and possible mitigative measures like dredging strengthening of river training works;
- Identifying probable erosion prone areas at the vicinity of the bridge one year in advance thus facilitating the planning of necessary monitoring and maintenance measures against possible adversities.
- Evaluation of the effectiveness of the present ongoing monitoring programme.

The services includes:

- Bathymetric data collection in the vicinity of the Jamuna Bridge for pre monsoons and monsoons 2007 and 2008 and discharge measurement in the Jamuna at the vicinity of the bridge during 2007 and 2008 monsoon.
- Updating the existing morphological model of the Jamuna Bridge available at IWM for the collected pre monsoons and monsoons 2007-2008 bathymetric data
- Applying this updated model for issuing forecast in terms of hydraulic and morphological developments around the river training structures of the bridge during the following 2 (two) monsoons (2008-2009)
- Preparing a monitoring program for each monsoons (2007-2008) for assisting the JMBA in drawing up systematic monitoring activities for maintenance measures of the bridge
- Disseminating technology to JMBA through local training
- Evaluation of the effectiveness of the present ongoing monitoring programme
- Design of river training works required to be taken.

Required Experience: The consultants shall have 15 (fifteen) years experience in mathematical modelling study, hydraulic design and other necessary works as stated in the scope of services at least 5 (five) projects in home or in abroad during the last 3 (three) years.

Superintending Engineer, JMBA now invites eligible applicants to indicate their interest in providing the services. Interested consultants are invited to provide information indicating that they are qualified to perform the services along with brochures, description of similar assignments, experience in similar operating conditions, availability of appropriate professionals, qualification and experience among staff, necessary equipments & technology along with software etc.

Consultant may associate with other consultants to enhance their qualifications. Association with foreign firms is encouraged but not mandatory.
