Bangladesh Water Supply Program Project (BWSPP) has been allocated public funds from the Government of the People's Republic of Bangladesh (GoB) toward the cost of the Bangladesh Water Supply Program Project (BWSPP), and it intends to apply part of the proceeds of these funds to payments under the contract for the provision of providing services on Community Development and Arsenic Mitigation Program under Bangladesh Water Supply Program Project (BWSPP) in 3 Arsenic hot spot upazilas of Munshiganj district by Support Organisations/NGOs.

The Services include:

Request for Expressions of Interest (EOI) for Short listing of Support Organisations/NGOs for providing services on Community Development and Arsenic Mitigation Program under Bangladesh Water Supply Program Project (BWSPP) in 3 Arsenic hot spot upazilas of Munshiganj district.

1. The People's Republic of Bangladesh has received a grant (Grant H-101-BD) from the International Development Association (IDA) and intends to apply part of the proceeds of this grant to pay for services for community development and arsenic mitigation in 3 arsenic prone upazilas of Munshiganj district under the contract Packages No S-3134, S-3135 and S-3136.

2. Government of Bangladesh (GOB), through Department of Public Health Engineering (DPHE), is implementing Bangladesh Water Supply Program Project (BWSPP) with the assistance of IDA with an aim to scale up the provision of safe water supply free from arsenic and pathogens in rural areas and small towns to contribute to Bangladesh's efforts to achieve the Millennium Development Goals (MDGs) in water supply and sanitation by 2015.

3. Community Development and Arsenic Mitigation activities will include capacity building at village level involving Local Government entities leading to i) Orientation Workshop at Upazilas and Unions, ii) Training for Community Development Promoters, iii) Formation of Ward Arsenic Mitigation Water Users Group (WAMWUG), iv) Training of WAMWUG, v) Development and approval of Ward Action Plans (WAPs) for sustainable supply of arsenic-safe drinking water, vi) Implementation of WAPs, vii) Water quality testing, viii) Post implementation work and ix) Reporting.

4. The Project Director of BWSPP now invites Expression of Interest (EOI) from eligible support Organizations/NGOs for the required services as mentioned above. Expression of Interest (EOI) should be submitted separately for each package.

5. Interested applicants may receive documents for background information from the office of the Project Director, BWSPP, 14 Shahid Captain Mansur Ali Sarani, DPHE Bhaban (5th floor), Kakrail, Dhaka-1000 during office hours in all working days on or before 28-02-2007 free of cost. - Interested applicant (Support Organizations/NGOs) must have formal registration with the appropriate authority of the government.
- Interested applicant should have 08 years experience in community capacity building activities.
- Of the 08 years the applicant should have 05 years experience in service related field like: arsenic screening/arsenic mitigation/community development/water and sanitation/health and training.

d. Working experiences with the local government institutions, particularly with Union Parishad will be an added advantage.

Bangladesh Water Supply Program Project (BWSPP) now invites eligible applicants to indicate their interest in providing the services. Interested consultants are invited to provide information indicating that they are qualified to perform the services (brochures, description of similar assignments, experience in similar operating conditions, availability of appropriate professional qualification and experience among staff, etc). Applicants may associate with other applicants to enhance their qualifications, and though not mandatory, association with foreign firms is not encouraged in this instance.

Support organizations/NGOs will be selected using the quality and cost based selection (QCBS) procurement method in accordance with the Public Procurement Regulations 2003 and Public Procurement Procedures issued by the GOB.
