Request for Expressions of Interest (EOI) for Selection of Production House for Organising Cultural

Programme Through Traditional Folk Media at Village

Level (Contract Package No. S-42229)

1. The Bangladesh Water Supply Programme Project (BWSP) has been allocated public funds from the Government of the People's Republic of Bangladesh (GoB) from the development budget toward the cost of the Bangladesh Water Supply Programme Project (BWSP), and it intends to apply part of the proceeds of these funds to payments under the contract for the provision of consultancy services for providing services for the "Organising Cultural Programme Through Traditional Folk Media at Village Level" (Contract Package No. S-42229)" for the project by a Production House (National).

2. Government of Bangladesh (GOB), through Department of Public Health Engineering (DPHE), is implementing BWSP with the assistance of International Development Association (IDA) with an aim to scale up the provision of safe water supply free from arsenic and pathogens in rural areas and small towns to contribute to Bangladesh's efforts to achieve the Millennium Development Goals (MDGs) in water supply and sanitation by 2015. The BWSP programme for safe water supply and sanitation includes piped water supply in 300 villages, expansion and promoting water supply in 5 municipalities and non-piped water supply in 200 villages with private sector participation.

Governments around the world are increasingly recognising the need to understand and engage stakeholders in the process of public sector reform to build support for change and to ensure long-term sustainability. These new and innovative institutional arrangement needs to be disseminated very effectively through a well planned Communication Strategy.

Keeping short term and long term objectives of communication intervention initiative has been taken to disseminate key messages amongst community people through organising traditional folk-based cultural programmes. Communication through traditional folk format would help creating a positive impact to uphold the BWSP activities. The aim of this TOR is to contract an experienced Consulting Firm/Production House, who will organise traditional folk-based cultural programmes at villages highlighting the key messages of the project.

3. Objective: The overall objective of the services to be provided under this contract is to organise 60 cultural events in 60 villages under the project to make aware the general masses about the importance of the use of safe water and personal hygiene.

4. The scope of services:

The Consulting Firm/Production House will collect, analyse

synthesise the available information/data/reports on project intervention and the use of safe water. Following the analysis of available documents and other information the Consulting Firm/Production House will develop an inception report, develop lyrics for dissemination of messages; make a work plan and implement the same. The Consulting Firm/Production House will submit the draft of the developed messages and work plan to the PMU for approval.

5. The Experience Resources and Delivery Capacity required: IDA's guideline will be followed for selecting Production House. The necessary requirements are:

5.1 Experience of organising traditional cultural events at grassroots level to disseminate development messages (minimum 10 events).

5.2 At least five years of experiences for organising cultural events/production of audiovisual programmes of which one must be on promotion of WatSan issues.

5.3 The Production House will be short-listed/selected using the Quality and Cost Based Selection (QCBS) procurement method in accordance with the Public Procurement Regulations (PPR) 2003 and Public Procurement Procedures issued by the GoB.

6. The EOIs received will be reviewed for short-listing on the basis of the following:

(i) Registration and age of the firm;

(ii) Record of competency in organising cultural activities/programmes in Bangladesh;

(iii) Experience of working in the rural areas of Bangladesh;

(iv) Knowledge of traditional folk media and folk entertainment;

(v) Availability of appropriate human and logistic resources;

(vi) Adequacy of resources for timely delivery of contracted services;

(vii) Knowledge about rural environment and culture;

(viii) Profile of the organisation, description of similar assignments, experience in similar operating conditions, availability of appropriate professional qualification and experience among manpower including Lyric Writer; Chief Coordinator, Team Leader-Music Group, and Singers etc.

8. It is expected that completion of the production will take approximately 6 months. Over this period the Production House will develop an inception report, develop lyrics for dissemination of messages; make a work plan and implement the same with the guidance from the BWSP Project Management Unit (PMU).

9.
