## Invitation for Expression of Interest (EOI)

- This invitation for expression of interest follows listing of the project that appeared in the 'Asian Development Bank Business Opportunities (ADB-BO)' on 12 August, 2004 (On-line).
- The Custom House of Chittagong (CHC) of National Board of Revenue (NBR) has received a loan amount of US\$ 12.60 million out of US\$ 30.60 million from Asian Development Bank (ADB) towards the cost of implementing the project named 'Chittagong Port Trade Facilitation Project (ADB Loan # 2147 BAN)' (CHC Component). Counterpart local fund amounts to BDT 398.14 lakh will be financed from Bangladesh Government own resources. The objective of the project is to activate ASYCUDA ++ Computer system of Custom House of Chittagong (CHC) interfaced with the Chittagong Port Authority (CPA)'s computer system and installation of container scanners needed to meet new security initiatives.
- The Custom House of Chittagong (CHC) under National Board of Revenue, IRD, Ministry of Finance, Government of Bangladesh will be the Executing Agency (EA) for the aforesaid components of the project.
- The Custom House of Chittagong (CHC) now invites Expression of Interest (EOI) from reputed audit firms for short-listing to appoint an audit firm to perform the audit works on financial statements and project accounts of the above stated ADB funded project with a separate report after conducting performance audit.
- The main objectives of the audits cover the following:
  - Express opinion on the EA's and the contractors' compliance with the terms of loan agreement and applicable rules, and regulations of ADB and others;
  - Measure the extent to which the programme was achieving its objectives and whether targeted outputs and outcomes were achieved;
  - Assess whether funds provided in the project were utilised economically, efficiently and effectively;
  - Examine and measure if outputs have achieved physical targets and were completed in time;
  - Assess actual quality of works compared to designs/specifications;
  - Assess economy and quality of procurements, and if goods procured were effectively utilised and exist at the location;
  - Evaluate the soundness and adequacy of the financial management system of the EA, in comparison with the international practices acceptable to ADB, and the requirement of borrower, and
  - Recommend measures for improving the performance of the project.
- The audit scope refers to the framework, boundary, limit, subject, issues and nature of the audit. The specific scope of the audits covers all operations of the entire project and loan agreement for the concerned project. The scope was determined based on the objectives of the audit, matters that are significant to the concerned projects, including areas of high risk, and issues, which are likely to add value and be of interest to ADB, and to the Government of Bangladesh, and to be consistent with ADB "Guideline for Conducting Project Performance Assessments". Specially for the project covered by the audits the auditors will:
 

**A Financial Audits:**

  - Carry out the audits in accordance with International Standard on Auditing, and include such tests and controls as the auditors consider necessary;
  - Audit of the financial statements of the Project & Project Account as formatted by ADB;
  - To observe the methods of record keeping and to comment on whether the followed methods are in conformity with GAAP & IAS/BAS.
  - Audit every cost based project activity funded under the loan agreements;
  - Verify if ADB's "Guideline for the Financial Management of Investment Projects Financed by the ADB" has been followed, and report on deviations;
  - Verify if records have been kept, of all significant assets financed under the projects, in a fixed asset register;
  - Verify if payments are being made in accordance with the provisions of relevant contracts;
  - Verify if: (a) external funds have been used, (b) counterpart funds have been provided, and (c) financial statements have been prepared, in accordance with loan agreements, and International Accounting Standards;
  - Audit all statements of expenditure used as a basis for withdrawal applications;
  - Verify if Government of Bangladesh (GOB) financial rules and regulations have followed, and report on deviation and contradictions with loan agreement and
  - Verify if special accounts are maintained following ADB and GOB rules, and examine the fund flow status.

**B. Performance Audits:**

  - Carry out the audits in accordance with International Standard on Auditing and include such tests and controls as the auditors consider necessary, or are required by the ADB "Guidelines for Conducting Project Performance Assessments";
  - Examine the project financial management systems, the EA's financial management system, and recommend improvements and actions to harmonize them in order to improve control;
  - Verify compliance with ADB's "Policy on Involuntary Resettlement," "Handbook on Resettlement", "Environmental Assessment Guidelines", and environmental rules and regulations of GOB;
  - Verify if ADB's "Guideline for Procurement", "Guidelines on the Use of Consultants," and GOB Public Procurement Regulations-2003 have been followed, and report on contradictions between the ADB Guidelines and PPR, delays, and reasons for delays in procurement and recruitment;
  - Verify the physical and financial progress the project and to comment on where improvement is needed;
  - Verify whether goods, services and works are being used for intended project purposes including technical assistance/consultancy provided for the project, and have achieved desired performance indicators. In absence of established performance indicators propose such based on the loan agreement;
  - Review variation orders and changes to original contracts with a view to: (a) document if procedures and guidelines as agreed in the loan agreement are followed, and (b) determine the cause of the variation order;
  - Examine the overall disbursement performance of the projects and identify the reasons for delays, if any;
  - Verify and evaluate adequacy of quality assurance procedures, and quality control organisation on the consultants, as well as the EA's side; and
  - Verify any other financial matters related to this project and prepare variance analysis of target with actual achievement.
- The audit team may be formed three to five key members with the backgrounds indicated in the "Guideline for Conducting Project Performance Assessments". In addition by the support and assisting staff as required by the audit firm. The tentative time of the audit would be 13 weeks.
- The Expression of Interest must include in the following information:
  - Background of the firm(s) with brochures etc.;
  - General and overall experience of the firm(s);
  - Annual turnover of the firm(s) for the last 03 (three) years with audited reports;
  - Nature, cost per months inputs, employer, location and field of input for the works in hand;
  - Experience of firm(s) in the required area of expertise.
  - Summary of permanent professional staff with key qualifications.
- The consulting services will require to be appointed by CHC in accordance with "ADB's Guidelines on the Use of Consultant". Only individual consulting firms are being invited to submit their EOI for short-listing. The capabilities of only the Lead Partner, in case the EOI submitted by a Joint Venture (JV) will be evaluated and only the Lead Partner will be short-listed. The CHC will not entertain any claim whatsoever in this respect from other partners of the JV for not short-listing their name along with the Lead Partner. Quality and cost based selection (QCBS) procedure will be followed for selection of the consultants and they will be engaged in accordance with "the guidelines on the use of consultants by Asian Development Bank and its borrowers."
