



HC issues rule on Tarique's detention

Asks govt to explain in 10 days why it is not illegal

BSS, Dhaka

The High Court (HC) yesterday issued a rule asking the government to explain why the detention of BNP Senior Joint Secretary General Tarique Rahman should not be declared illegal and without lawful authority.

After hearing a criminal miscellaneous petition filed by his wife Dr Jubaida Rahman challenging the legality of the detention of her husband, a division bench comprising Justice Abdul Wahab Miah and Justice Mohammad Endadul Haque issued the rule, which is returnable within 10 days.

The law enforcers arrested Tarique Rahman, the eldest son of former prime minister Khaleda Zia, from his cantonment residence on March 8. He was produced before the Chief Metropolitan
