

Teletalk Bangladesh Limited emerged out of people's desire for 'Deshi Mobile Phone' on this very day in 2005 triggering mad rush of people to avail their long cherished mobile phone services from government sector. At the time Teletalk entered the market, there prevailed high call rates. Teletalk broke the shackles of high tariff regime with low tariff and charged nothing for incoming calls from BTTB for the first time in Bangladesh. Teletalk launched its commercial operation on 31 March 2005 with astonishing low rate of Tk. 3 per minute, while prevailing average per minute call charge was as high as Tk. 7. As a consequence, all mobile operators started reducing their tariff and now in two years time average per minute rate is Tk. 2. Moreover, Teletalk was first to introduce free incoming calls from BTTB. Teletalk ushered the era of Private and Public sectors competition, an essential component of a liberalized market economy, in mobile telecommunication industry of the country.

Unlike other operators, Teletalk from its very first day of operation had coverage in all 61 district headquarters (3 Hill Track districts are not allowed for mobile coverage), major highways and numbers of upzillas in Bangladesh. From the very beginning, Teletalk has been offering simple to understand packages while subscribers are rather confused by most of the packages offered by other operators. Teletalk packages for both pre-paid and post-paid services are plain and transparent to users that they are devoid of any kind of hidden cost. Additionally, Teletalk offers most affordable call rates in the market keeping its promise of providing universal state of the art mobile telecommunication services all over the country at an affordable cost without compromising quality.

Teletalk is run entirely by local engineers and managers, while other operators heavily depend on foreign experts to run technical and managerial affairs in key positions. Thus Teletalk becomes only breeding ground for Bangladeshi experts to take leading positions in a highly specialized sector like mobile telecommunication. Teletalk started the culture of complete mobile communication services to all subscribers with ISD/EISD and both way land line connectivity, whereas other operators used to provide only mobile to mobile services to a large section of subscribers. Value added services like SMS, GPRS (Internet), push-pull etc are integral part of Teletalk mobile services on top its voice call facilities. Additionally, Teletalk was first to introduce life time mobile connectivity for its subscribers. With passage of time, people have increasing confidence on Teletalk's mobile phone services and in fact, it is the main impetus behind two years of success story of Teletalk.
