#### Preamble:

International Islamic University Chittagong (IIUC) is a Private University established in 1995 at Chittagong by a Trust named Islamic University Chittagong Trust (IUCT) with the initiative of a group of Educationist, Social Workers and Philanthropists of Chittagong - the gateway of Islam to Bengal. The Islamic University Chittagong Trust is a non-political, non-profit-oriented voluntary organization, founded in 1990 headed by late Moulana Abdul Jabbar, a renowned Islamic scholar and a religious leader. The need for establishing an Islamic University of International standard was felt due to the absence of Institutions of higher learning based on Islamic vision of education in public sector in any of the two big cities of Bangladesh.

#### IUC Trust: A Global Body

Islamic University Chittagong Trust (IUCT) is now a body consisting of a group of Intellectuals, Social Workers, Islamic Thinkers & Scholars, Researchers & Educationists of home & abroad, with Professor Dr. Abdullah Umar Naseef, the Ex-Vice-Chancellor of King Abdul Aziz University, Jeddah, K.S.A. and Former Secretary General of Rabatah-al-Alam al-Islami, as its Chairman, Prof. Dr. Abdullah Musleh, the Ex-Vice-Chancellor of Abha University of K.S.A. as one of its Vice-Chairmen, Prof. Dr. Yousuf al-Qaradawi of Qatar University, His Excellency Dr. Saleh bin Humaid, Speaker Majlis-al-Shura (Parliament) and Khatib of Masjidul Haram, Makka Mukarrama, His Excellency Mamoon Abdul Qayyum, President of the Republic of Maldives, Shaikh Nasir Hamadan Al-Za'abi, Chairman of the Islamic Solidarity Fund, OIC and many others as its members.

#### Academic Programs:

After getting approval of the Government on 11.02.1995 International Islamic University Chittagong (IIUC) started its academic activities with four departments under three Faculties and 47 students. Now upon having arrived at its 12th year by the grace of Almighty Allah (S.W.T.), there are five faculties and eleven departments while the number of students has increased to 5594 (10% increase in each year).

IIUC is offering education of International standard in three disciplines under the Faculty of Shari'ah e.g. Qur'anic Sciences, Da'wah & Islamic Studies and Hadith & Islamic Studies, in four disciplines under the Faculty of Modern Sciences e.g. Computer Science & Engineering, Computer & Communication Engineering, Electrical & Electronic Engineering and Pharmacy, in one discipline under the Faculty of Business Studies e.g. BBA and MBA, in two disciplines under the Faculty of Arts & Humanities e.g. English Language & Literature and Arabic Language & Literature and lastly the Faculty of Laws is offering Bachelor & Master degree program in Law.

#### Its Status and Accreditation:

IIUC has been graded as one of the Top graded 9 (Nine) Private Universities of Bangladesh by the High Power Evaluation Team constituted by the then Prime Minister headed by the Chairman of UGC in 2002.

IIUC is the first University which has been accredited by the Board of Accreditation for Engineering & Technical Education (BAETE) for fulfilling all requirements in its CCE & CSE programs.

#### Infrastructure:

a) **Permanent Campus** situated at Kumira, Sitakunda, 22 kms away from the City Center on an area of 30 acres of land. The number of buildings are 12 (Faculty buildings - 5, Hostels - 4, Library - 1, Mosque - 1 & Auditorium - 1). One residential building for Academic Staff Members is in the process of construction.

b) **City Campus** situated near the Govt. College of Chittagong, being run in five Faculty buildings and three Hostels with a floor space of 1,03,341 sq. ft.

c) **Dhaka Campus** situated in Dhanmondi R/A and being run in four Faculty buildings, one Administrative Building and two hostels with a floor space of 87,183 sq. ft.

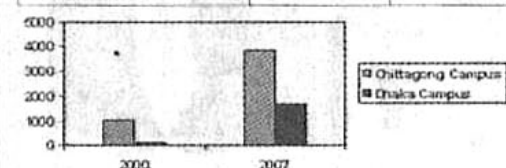

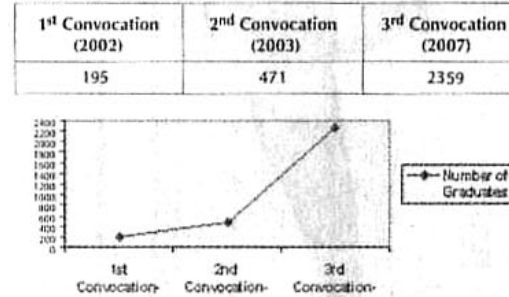

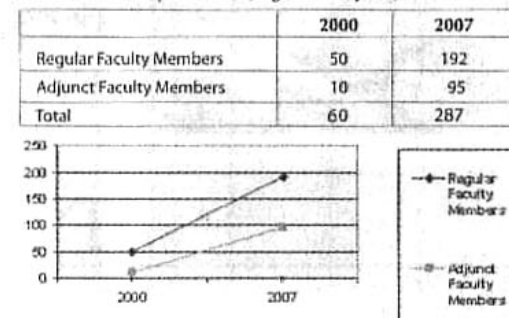
#### Number of Gold Medalists in Three Convocations:



#### Number of Graduates:

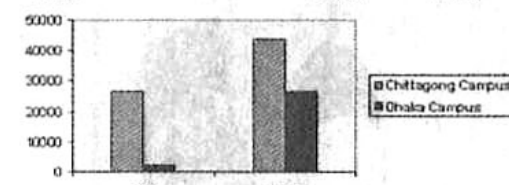
