

Mugging: Another succumbs to injuries

Critically injured Mohammad Amir, who was shot by the muggers on Monday night, succumbed to his injuries at the Combined Medical Hospital in the city yesterday noon. Witnesses said four to five assailants fired bullets at Ashraf Uddin Bhuiyan, 50, a teacher of the Dhaka Polytechnic Institute and superinten-

dent of Latif Hostel (east) and Mohammad Amir Haq, 40, a watchman of Bangladesh Air Force at Dhaka Cantonment and a part time electrician at Latif Hostel, as they came out of the hostel with Tk 1.70 lakh collected from the students as mess bill on Monday night. Ashraf died on the day of the incident. Investigation officer (IO) of the

case, Khan Mohammad Irfan of Tejgaon Industrial Area Police Station, told The Daily Star that they suspect mugging to be the main motive behind the incident. Police arrested two locals, Ramzan and Sabu, suspected to be involved in the incident. Police sent the arrestees to the court and asked for a 5-day remand.
