

Farmer injured in BSF firing

UNB, Joypurhat

Indian Border Security Force (BSF) opened fire at Uchna border in Panchbibi upazila yesterday morning, injuring a Bangladeshi farmer.

Farmer Abdur Rashid, 30, was admitted to Joypurhat Adhunik Hospital in a critical condition.

BDR sources said the BSF troops opened fire at about 5:00am without any provocation.

B'baria-Comilla direct bus service from Apr 20

Direct bus service between Brahmanbaria and Comilla, a long-felt demand of the people of two neighbouring districts, will begin on April 20.

The decision was taken at a meeting of BRTA at Brahmanbaria Deputy Commissioner's conference room on Wednesday.

Sources said the bus communication could not be established so long because of a dispute between the bus owners' associations of the two districts.
